JAMMU: Department of Wildlife Protection on Tuesday launched a massive drive against feeding of monkeys on roads by the people.

The drive has two components- awareness of the people with respect to the habit of throwing food articles on roads and the 2nd component is collection of such food articles directly from the people.

Speaking on the occasion, Suresh Kumar Gupta, Chief Wildlife Warden said that there are instances of monkeys being injured and killed on the road which is a violation of Wildlife Protection Act. He said that the Department has put up a number of hoardings along the roads for awareness of the people against the menace of throwing food on the road for the monkeys.

In pursuance of Notification No. 124-BOPEE of 2021 dated 12-11-2021, read with other Notifications / Notices, the Board conducted 3rd (Mop up) round of physical counselling from 20-11-2021 and 22-11-2021 simultaneously at BOPEE office/Jammu/Srinagar for admission to B.E/B. Tech (Engineering) courses-2021 in Govt./Private Engineering Colleges of UT of Jammu and Kashmir. The list of candidates provisionally selected for upgradation/allotment of seat(s) in respective Colleges / Institutions as per their merit cum preferences is given at Annexure "A" to this Notification which shall be available on BOPEE official website www.jkbopee.gov.in only.

The candidates provisionally upgraded / selected shall have to report for admission to the allotted Colleges / Institutions by or before 29th of November 2021 (up to 04:00 P.M) along with their relevant certificates in original. The concerned Heads of the Institutions shall complete the admission process after checking the eligibility of candidates and verifying the following documents:

1. Domicile Certificate.
2. Marks Certificate of 12th Class.
3. Date of Birth Certificate (10th Marks Sheet/Diploma).
4. Category Certificate, if applicable.
5. ID card to verify the identity of the candidate, &
6. Any other document, as required by concerned college/institution for admission purposes.

Note:

1. All the Heads of the Institutions/Colleges are requested to keep their admission counters open on holidays/off days to facilitate the candidates to complete their admission process well in time.
2. The candidate(s) who would conceal any information at the time of admission, the candidature of such candidates shall be cancelled abinitio and fine/penalty shall be imposed upon him/her as may be deemed proper by the Board in accordance with the laid down rules.
3. The allotment of seats (discipline/institution) have been made in accordance to the provisions of S.O. 127 of 2020 dated 20-04-2020 read with S.O. 249 of 2021 dated 23-07-2021.
4. The Concerned Colleges/Institutions shall ensure that, in case a person with disability, is selected in open merit, the college/ institution concerned shall refer such case(s) to the Medical College concerned for constitution of special Medical Board to assess such candidates and make recommendations based on which colleges shall take further necessary action. In case any such candidate does not fulfill the bench marks of disability, he/she shall not be admitted to the course/ college and the matter shall be reported to the BOPEE. 5.
5. For fee related query, candidates provisionally recommended for admission are advised to contact the concerned College/Institution.

Further, due to non-availability of eligible reserved category candidates in the following Institutions against below mentioned categories, the Board, as provided under Proviso to Selection 9(2) of J&K Reservation Act, 2004, converted these seats into Open Merit and filled up the same from amongst the available eligible OM category candidates.
