CRIME REPORT

Driver killed as tanker falls into gorge on Jammu-Srinagar highway

BANITHAL/JAMMU: A 55-year-old tanker driver was killed when his vehicle skidded off the road and plunged into a deep gorge along Jammu-Srinagar national highway, police said on Wednesday.

The tanker, carrying diesel to Srinagar, rolled down into a 500-feet gorge at Shaitani Nallah late on Tuesday, said Harnam Singh, Incharge Police Post, Jawahar Tunnel said. The body of tanker driver, identified as Isher Dass of Kathua district, was retrieved from gorge and handed over to his family members for performing last rites after completion of legal formalities, added Singh.

**Rs 21, 400 fine from recovered SoPs violators in Ramban**

RAMBAN: Continuing enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Wednesday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 21,400 Taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs 67,24,600.

The Enforcement officers urged people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 903 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district. As per daily bulletin issued by Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1,595 samples including 353 RT-PCR and 1,242 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 903 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

**Two peddlers arrested with heroin**

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police achieved major success by recovering 220 gm heroin from two drug peddlers during Naka checking at different locations i.e., Roop Nagar and Panama Chowk.

As per details, on receiving an local intelligence, a team from Janipur Police Station led by SHO Janipur Inspr Nayat Ali under supervision of SP North Mohita Sharma laid Naka and rounded up a suspect who tried to run away on seeing police but was overpowered due to swift action of police. On search, 200 gm heroin was recovered from possession of suspect later identified as Arjun Singh, son of Shamsher Singh, resident of village Lahri Bawian, Tehsil Pathankot at present Jariai Morh, Kathua. He was arrested and FIR No 121/2021 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Janipur.

The overall arrest and recovery was made under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar.

In another incident, during routine patrolling, Police party led by PSI Balbir Singh from Police Station Trikuta Nagar noticed movement of a suspect. On being asked to stop for checking, he started running away which created suspicion. After a brief chase, he was overpowered by alert cops. On search, 20.86 gm heroin like substance was recovered from his possession. Later, he was identified as Gursant Singh, son of late Manjeet Singh, resident of Ward No-1 Simbal Camp Tehsil R S Pura, Jammu. He further disclosed that the consignment of heroin was supposed to be delivered among youth in the adjoining areas. FIR No. 378/21 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against the accused at Police Station Trikuta Nagar. The entire operation was conducted under the guidance of Insp Deepak Pathania SHO Trikuta Nagar, under supervision of Sajjad Sarwar SDPO City East, Deepak Digra SP City South Jammu.

## Bomb hoax inside J&K Bank creates panic; Police terms it as CI drill

JAMMU: A bomb hoax in J&K Bank, branch Janipur created panic in the area on Wednesday, however later police termed it as counter insurgency (CI) mock drill.

As per details, panic gripped in Janipur area after a bomb hoax at J&K Bank branch following which police, SOG and other agencies rushed to spot and evacuated costumers of bank and shopping complex. Later, police termed it as a CI drill. "A CI drill was conducted in Janipur area of Jammu on Wednesday which is routine within security set-up. People are requested to refrain from rumour mongering," said SSP Jammu, Chandan Kohli.

## Blood-ridden body of labourer found

SAMBA: A blood-ridden body of a labourer was found in Supwal area on Wednesday.

As per details, a man who was working in Madhuban Eatery at Supwal area was murdered as his blood-ridden body was found near a shed nearby. On seeing his body, locals informed police which rushed to the spot and shifted body to morgue. The FSL team was also called which collected evidences from the spot. The owner of eatery Virender Sharma told police that the deceased, identified as Raju, was working with him for last 10-12 years.

## Massive crackdown against traffic violators; 260 booked

RAMBAN: Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Massarat Islam on Wednesday led a team of Motor Vehicle Department (MVD) for checking of vehicles on Jammu-Srinagar National Highway, as a part of massive crackdown on transporters indulged in overloading, over-speeding and other violations of rules.

During checking at Naka near Maroge, the Deputy Commissioner inspected several vehicles and advised passengers to check condition of vehicle and other necessary documents before starting their journey. The DC informed that during the drive, the Motor Vehicle Department Ramban has checked nearly 1,700 vehicles and Challenged 260 transporters for different violations under MVD Act.

The DC said that MVD has also intensified an awareness drive across the district to sensitise people, especially drivers and conductors about traffic rules as well as

road safety measures to avoid accidents. Traffic Police and District Police have also intensified checking drives in view of frequent accidents on Jammu-Srinagar National Highway due to negligent driving, he added.

Meanwhile, Assistant Regional Transport Officer, Shafqat Majid informed that the MVD checking squad inspected more than 300 vehicles, out of which 4 were seized while 37 were booked for violations of rules during checking on Wednesday. ARTO and SHO Ramban Sandeep Charak also sensitized the drivers and transporters about traffic rules and documents required during driving.

## Missing youth's body found
