CRIME REPORT

Medicines theft case: One more arrested, medicines worth Rs 1,15,000 recovered

JAMMU: In continuation to case related to theft in medical shop at City, one more arrest has been made and more medicines worth Rs 1,15,000 have been recovered.

As per details, during questioning of the earlier arrested accused in the case, name of one more accused popped up. On this special police teams of Police Station City under supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu were constituted and a team led by SHO City Insp Vijay Kumar assisted by PSI Gurminder Singh and PSI Amit Kumar did strenuous efforts and finally arrested accused namely Hitesh Sharma, son of Kali Dass, resident of Chombian Tehsil Bishnah District Jammu. During questioning, the accused confessed his involvement in the crime and on his disclosure medicines worth Rs 1,15,000 were recovered. On this FIR No. 73/2021 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station City. Total consignment of medicines recovered till now amounts to Rs. 1,95,000.



Woman held for illicit distillation; approx 15 lts Desi liquor seized

KATHUA: In a decisive action against illegal liquor menace in the district, Kathua police under overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Thursday seized 15 litres of illicit liquor near Kukachak in Kathua and arrested a woman in this regard.

As per details, a team of Police Station Kathua led by Insp Om Parkash Chib SHO Kathua under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammi Kumar during patrolling duty near agriculture nursery at Kukachak apprehended a suspect namely Rajni Devi, wife of Parvesh Kumar, resident of Chak Drab Khan, Tehsil & District Kathua. On checking, approximately 15 lts illicit liquor was recov-

ered from her possession. She was arrested and FIR No. 495/2021 under section 48 (A) Excise Act was registered against her at Police Station Kathua.

Missing woman traced, reunited with family

KATHUA: Police on Thursday traced out a missing woman and reunited her with family members.

As per details, on June 1, 2021, a missing report was lodged at Police Station Billawar by Neeraj Bhagat, husband of the woman stating therein that his wife namely Poonam Devi, resident of Jammu and presently Pathyal Tehsil Billawar District Kathua went missing. Accordingly, missing report was lodged and search was started to trace her. Acting instantly on missing report, the aforesaid woman was traced and immediately handed-over to legal heirs after completion of all legal formalities.

ATM fraudsters' gang busted; 3 arrested

RAMBAN: Police on Thursday busted a gang of ATM fraudsters by arrested three accused persons in Ramban.

As per details, on Nov 20, 2021, a written complaint was filed by one Ranjeet Singh Parihar, son of Keshav Ram, resident of Karol, Ramban stating that three unknown non-locals exchanged and swapped his ATM card when he has gone to withdraw cash from an ATM of SBI Bank. On receipt of complaint, FIR No. 201/2021 under sections 379/420/401 of IPC was registered at Police Station Ramban and investigation started.

During the course of investigation it surfaced that some non-locals were involved in the crime. After making stringent efforts, a party from Police Station Ramban led by SHO Ramban arrested three non-locals namely Deepak, son of Krishan, resident of Meham, District Rohtak, Haryana; Jonny, son of Zile Singh, resident of Mokhra, District Rohtak, Haryana and Ajit Singh, son of Ram Kishan, resident of Barsi, Tehsil Bhawani-Khera, Haryana at present staying at Sultanpuri, Delhi. In all, 48 ATM cards of 15 different banks and cash amount of Rs 41,000, three mobile phones along with 5 SIM cards and magnetic card reader device were recovered from their possession. A swift



car (DL 4CAZ 5408) was seized in the instant case. Further during investigation, the owners of 32 ATM cards were contacted and out of them, 5 owners confirmed that their accounts have been transacted fraudulently and their ATM cards have been exchanged by unknown persons at various ATM booths. Two transactions were done by accused persons in district Jammu in which amounts of Rs 12,500 and 15,500 respectively were deducted from the accounts of victims. Further investigation in the case is going on. The arrest as well recovery was made by team of Police Station Ramban headed by SHO Ramban Inspector Sandeep Charak under overall supervision of DySP headquarters Ramban Pardeep Singh Sen.

Rape case reported
