JAMMU: The Director General of Jammu and Kashmir Police, Dilbag Singh on Thursday said that some people are looking at the killers as innocent people.

While responding to a question about Mehbooba Mufti's aspersions about Rambagh encounter, Singh during a press conference at Jammu said that some people deliberately try to ignore the reality and give statements which are far from reality and these people have started to look at the killers as innocent people.

According to Srinagar based news agency, Kashmir News Service (KNS), Singh, while replying to a question regarding Hyderpora encounter, said that there is no doubt that some civilians were killed during the encounter but after that dozens of successful anti-terrorism

NIA carries out searches in Al-Qaeda related case in Kashmir



The NIA said the raids were carried out at five locations in south Kashmir's Shopian district and central Kashmir's Budgam district. A large number of incriminating documents and digital devices were seized, it added.

The case pertains to Umar Halmandi, an Al-Qaeda operative, who along

During the search of the truck, police seized 52 kilogram of heroin worth Rs 100 crore in the international market, he said.

However, the driver of the truck managed to escape, the police official said.

But co-driver, identified as Bharat Kumar of Haryana, was arrested, he added.

During initial investigation, it came to the fore that the consignment of heroin was being smuggled to Punjab from Srinagar in Kashmir, the ADGP said.

Pockets containing heroin have 1999 markings, which points towards its smuggling into J-K from Pakistan to fund terrorism, he said.

Earlier seizures of heroin had similar markings as well, he added.

Giving further information, Mukesh Singh said police have seized 185 kilogram of heroin worth Rs 360 crore in the past two years

JEWAR (UP): Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday laid the foundation stone for the Noida International Airport at Jewar in Uttar Pradesh.

It will be one of the largest aerodromes in Asia.

The airport, the second international aerodrome in Delhi-National Capital Region, is expected to be operational by September 2024 with an initial capacity to handle 1.2 crore passengers per annum.
