

AHD Jammu inaugurates maiden 'Pashu-Mandi'

JAMMU: Marching towards attaining self sufficiency in milk production, the Department of Animal Husbandry Jammu, under the guidance of Principal Secretary to the Government Animal/Sheep Husbandry & Fisheries Department, Navin Kumar Choudhary, on Sunday organised first ever Pashu-Mandi in the UT of J&K at RP Check post, Lakhnupur (Kathua).

Director Animal Husbandry Jammu Dr. Sagar D. Doifode inaugurated the event. He

apprised the dairy farmers and breeders that it was the first kind of initiative taken by the department with active support from the district administration Kathua. He assured the farmers that such events will be made a regular feature in the region providing an ideal platform to our dairy farmers to obtain best dairy breeds of cows/buffaloes from the neighbouring states leading to enhanced milk production locally.

District Development Commissioner Kathua Rahul Yadav complimented

the department of Animal Husbandry Jammu for the initiative for achieving rural prosperity and also assured full support in organizing more such events in the future.

The DC Kathua further said that a duty magistrate has been stationed at the RP Checkpost, Lakhnupur to facilitate the hassle free induction and transportation of the animals purchased at the mandi. Moreover a single-window clearance mechanism is
