DB asks Contempt Court not to pass any coercive orders against Chairman AAI

JAMMU: A Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court comprising Chief Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey and Justice Punit Gupta in an application, asked Contempt Court not to pass any coercive orders against the Chairman, Airport Authority of India qua compliance of Judgment passed by the Writ Court. This significant order has been passed in an application filed by Chairman, Airports Authority of India & Ors for issuance of a direction staying the operation of the impugned Judgment dated May 4, 2022 passed by the learned Single Judge in the Writ Petition filed by the Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein, in terms whereof, the Writ Court, while allowing the Writ Petition, has quashed the proceedings initiated by the Respondents/ Appellants herein with regard to the penalty of Censure dated October 31, 2001 against the Writ Petitioner/

Respondent herein disentitling him for back dated promotion to the post of DGM (ATC) as well as order of Censure issued on October 31, 2001 conveyed to Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein vide communication dated January 21, 2009, besides directing the Respondents/ Appellants herein to grant the benefit of next higher scale of DGC (ATC) to the Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein (now retired) w.e.f. January 10, 1999, along with consequential benefits including arrears of emoluments and post retrial benefits.

Division Bench after hearing D C Raina, Senior Advocate with Vishal Sharma, DSGI and Adv. Yatin Mahajan, appearing on behalf of the applicants/ Appellants, submitted that in terms of the scheme of law governing the subject, the Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein is not entitled to the aforesaid benefits as awarded to him by the Writ Court. It is contended that

the applicants/ Appellants have already assailed the aforesaid Judgment passed by the learned Single Judge in appeal wherein notice has already been issued in the accompanying application seeking condonation of delay, but since the Contempt Court has issued notice in the proceedings filed by the Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein and is asking for compliance of the Judgment, therefore, a need has arisen for the applicants/ Appellants for filing the instant application. It is pleaded that, in the event the Contempt Court passes any coercive orders/ direction with regard to the implementation of the aforesaid Judgment, the appeal filed by the applicants/ Appellants would be rendered infructuous inasmuch as there would be nothing for the applicants/ Appellants to agitate in the appeal before this Court. DB after perusal of the note of the Registry reveals that the statutory period with regard to the

notice issued in the condonation of delay application is yet to expire. However, given the nature of submissions made by the learned Senior Counsel as detailed out hereinabove and having regard to the fact that the Contempt Petition filed by the Writ Petitioner/ Respondent herein is listed today before the Contempt Court, we deem it proper and, accordingly, ask the Registry to issue fresh notice to the Respondent through Process Serving Agency of the concerned District Court, returnable on or before the next date of hearing. The notice, as aforesaid, shall be issued both in the condonation of delay application as well as in the instant application. DB directed that the application be listed along with main case on December 23, 2022 and till then, Court asked Contempt Court not to pass any coercive orders against the Applicants/ Appellants qua compliance of aforesaid Judgment passed by the Writ Court.

PIL on preservation, conservation of Dal Lake: VC JKLCMA directed to submit details of works done

JAMMU: In a Public Interest Litigation PIL on preservation and conservation of Dal Lake, which was initiated in 2002 on basis of a letter of one Syed Iqbal Tahir Geelani, a student of 6th Semester LLB, University of Kashmir high-

lighting miserable condition of various water-bodies and lakes which at one time were the lifeline of the valley, a Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court comprising Chief Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey and Justice Punit Gupta in an application, directed Vice Chairman, Jammu and Kashmir Lakes Conservation and Management Authority, (JKLCMA) to file an affidavit stating details of what has happened during last two months on order passed by the Court for cleaning, development and upkeep of lakes, especially Dal.

When the PIL came up for hearing, DB observed that there is no response filed by State authorities in terms of

order dated September 8, 2022. DB further said that a need for asking the Advocate General to take appropriate steps to get the area of buffer zone around the Dal lake re-examined by the State authorities and placing of the same on record has arisen, as applications bearing CM Nos. 3445, 1548, 4896/2022, 8454/2021 and 2091/2022 were filed by the applicants seeking permission to raise the constructions in the area as per the Master Plan 2035. DB further observed that since 2002 directions were passed from time to time to address the miserable conditions of the various water bodies and lakes for cleaning, development and upkeep of lakes especially of Dal lake and the construction works within

200 mt of the periphery of the Dal lake were stopped but, in the meanwhile, some applications were filed seeking permission for repairs/renovation in modification of the order passed on 19th July 2002. The aforesaid directions contained in order 19th July 2002 have been appropriately modified and relaxed by the consequent upon orders passed by this Court on various occasions and the applicants seeking such repairs and re-constructions in and around the Dal Lake were asked to approach the Lakes and Waterways Development Authority (for short 'LAWDA') for placing the same before the competent authority, (JKLCMA) on affidavit by the next date, a copy whereof be provided to the learned Amicus in advance.

As approved by the competent authority it is for the information of all the candidates who have appeared in SKUAST-J CET 2022 (PG) that the counselling for M.V.Sc.
