CRIME REPORT

Woman dies while saving sons in house collapse

BHADARWAH: In a shocking incident, a 38-year-old woman got killed after her house collapsed due to landslide in Butla area of Bhadarvah on Tuesday morning. The deceased woman was identified as Kirna Devi. After getting information about the incident, locals along with Police and Army's 4 RR Jawans started rescue operation and retrieved body of woman from the debris besides retrieving livestock from the house.

DDC Chairman Doda Dhananther Singh Kotwal, ADC Bhadarwah Dil Mir Choudhary and Tehsildar Bhadarwah Showket Hayat Mattoo also reached the spot. ADC Bhadarwah Dil Mir Choudhary said that the unfortunate incident happened in morning. According to ADC Bhadarwah, the house of Ved Kumar (42) came under landslide around 7:30 AM, in which his wife Kirna Devi (38) came under impact of debris, but she saved her two sons Mikal (15) and Nixon (11) by pushing them outside. ADC Bhadarwah said that after two hours of hectic efforts, woman was evacuated from the debris and shifted to SDH Bhadarwah, where doctors declared her as brought dead. Mikal, elder son of deceased said that my mother came under debris while saving my younger brother Nixon, who was sleeping when the house collapsed. He said that my mother pushed me and my sleeping brother outside as roof suddenly started coming down. Although she managed to push us outside but till then all roof fell over her. Meanwhile, ADC Bhadarwah said that an amount of Rs 25,000 has been immediately released by DC Doda Vishesh Paul Mahajan for family under disaster management. Army is also installing a tented accommodation for family beside a local NGO Ababeel has provided blankets, eatables and utensils. Locals demanded relief including compensation to poor family at the earliest considering the winter season. It is notable that higher reaches of Bhadarwah witnessed fresh snowfall, while rains lashed plains on Monday.

5 gamblers arrested, stake money seized

BANDIPORA: Acting tough against social crimes, Police on Tuesday arrested 5 gamblers and seized stake money from their possession.

Acting on specific information about gambling activities in Nowgam area of Sumbal, a police party of Police Post Nowgam led by Incharge PP Nowgam under the supervision of SDPO Sumbal Surinder Mohan & SHO Sumbal raided specific site and arrested 5 gamblers on the spot, who were iden-

tified as Shabir Ahmad Zadoo, Mohmad Maqbool Naikoo, Syed Reyaz, Bashir Ahmad Batoo & Kifayat Hussain Batoo, all residents of Nowgam, Sumbal. Officers also seized stake money amounting to Rs 3,420 and playing cards from gamblers. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 137/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Sumbal and investigation started.

Two bootleggers arrested, illicit liquor recovered

BANDIPORA/MIRAN SAHIB: Acting tough against social crimes, Police on Tuesday nabbed arrested two bootleggers and recovered illicit liquor from their possession.

As per details, information received at Police Station Miran Sahib regarding distillation of Desi liquor at village Khour: A party of Police Station Miran Sahib, led by SHO Miran Sahib Insp Zaheer Mushtaq assisted by Incharge Border Police Post Kullian ASI Ranjeet Singh under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and overall supervision of Sp Hqrs Rammish Gupta conducted raids at different locations and nabbed a person red-handed while manufacturing Desi liquor, later identified as Harbajan Singh, son of Kartar Singh, resident of village Khour, Deonian. He was arrested and 5 lts freshly prepared illicit liquor was recovered from his possession along with the utensils used for manufacturing desi liquor. Moreover, approximately more than 200 lts Lahan was recovered from the spot which was subsequently destroyed. FIR No 154/2022 under sections 48-e and 48-f of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Miran sahib.

Meanwhile, a party led by SHO Aragam under the supervision of DySP PC Bandipora Zafar Mehdi a checkpoint established near Wular Vintage Park Garoora intercepted a suspect identified as Ashiq Hussain Bhat, resident of Arin Bandipora. On checking, 7 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 45/2022 under relevant sections of law stands registered in Police Station Aragam and investigation initiated.

Akhnoor Police tightens noose over traffic violators

Narco-smuggler arrested; 5 gm heroin recovered
