The other issues of teaching fraternity which were discussed are release of ATD 2022, transition of Teachers Grade-II and Grade-III, framing of clear cut transfer policy in favour of teachers appointed under RET scheme, adjustment of all the promotee Headmasters and Lecturers, regularisation of all cadres and restoration of OPS instead of NPS to give sigh of relief to the aggrieved.
