Promotion of Patwaris: DB sets-aside CAT order, directs DPC not to make any recommendation

JAMMU: A Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court comprising Chief Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey and Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul set-aside order of Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) passed on 03.11.2022 with direction to the Tribunal to pass appropriate orders after hearing the parties either in the MA No. 964/2022 or in main OA. DB further directed that Tribunal shall take up the matter on 21.11.2022 and in the meantime, till decision is made by the Tribunal in the interim application/OA, the DPC shall not make any recommendation for promotion of Patwaris of District Shopian. Any observation made or finding recorded hereinabove, shall not form any basis for deciding the inter se merit of the parties in OA/interim application. The Tribunal shall ensure that appropriate orders are passed on the next date, so as to avoid any delay in proceedings.
