They raised slogans holding placards and organized an awareness rally in the college campus. Anti-tobacco education needs to be targeted at decision-makers, professionals and the general public, especially the youth. In India, chewing tobacco is slowly becoming endemic. As per section 6 of the COTPA, sale of cigarettes and other tobacco products within a 100-yard radius of educational institutions is deemed illegal.
