MVD Reasi Challans 25 buses plying without SLDs

REASI: A team of Motor Vehicle Department Reasi challaned 25 passenger buses on Tuesday found plying without Speed Limiting



Devices (SLDs) during a special Naka. The team, led by ARTO Reasi Rajesh Gupta conducted enforcement drive in different areas of Katra. During the drive, around 82 vehicles were checked with special emphasis on checking of Speed Limiting Devices (SLDs) in Passenger and School buses. The buses san SLDs were Challaned under relevant laws of Motor Vehicle Act, while School buses were plying smoothly with SLDs installed in them. The ARTO informed that 7 two-wheeler riders were also Challaned for riding without Helmets driving while 4 two-wheeler, without documents, were seized. Besides this, awareness was also imparted among drivers and public regarding Road safety. The School bus drivers were asked to adopt all safety measures in order to avoid accidents. Commercial vehicle drivers were directed not to resort to overload/overcharging and to follow traffic rules.

Man accused of raping 9-yr-old girl arrested

RAJOURI/JAMMU: A 35-year-old man was arrested from a village near Line of Control (LoC) in Rajouri district for allegedly raping a nine-year-old girl, police said on Tuesday. Ishfaq Lone, a resident of Narsoo village, was on run after relatives of victim lodged a complaint at Udhampur district on November 17, after which a case was registered under Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) and IPC sections, a police official said. Acting on information, a police team raided a house in Beti Patti village in Rajouri and nabbed accused, the official added.

Drug peddler nabbed with 9.24 gm heroin

KATHUA: Continuing its drive to contain spread of narcotics, Kathua Police under guidance of SSP R C Kotwal on Tuesday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered approximately 9.24 gm Heroin like narcotics from his possession. As per details, a team of Police Station Kathua led by Insp O P Chib SHO Kathua under the supervision of Incharge DySP Kathua Sukhdev Singh during checking duty in its jurisdictional area, apprehended a suspect identified as Raj Kumar, son of Kuldeep Singh, resident of Ward-7, Shalab Singh Nagar, Srinagar, Pathankot. During checking approximately 9.24 gm Heroin like narcotics was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 446/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Kathua.

5 drug-peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Tuesday arrested 5 drug-peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession. In Budgam, at a checkpoint established at Malpora crossing, a Police party of Police



Station Khag intercepted two suspects, who tried to flee from the spot however alert police party apprehended them tactfully. The accused were identified as Firdous Ahmad Mir, son of Ghulam Ahmad Mir, resident of Nussi Khag and Mohd Shafi Wani, son of Abdul Majed Wani, resident of Hanji Lawpura Beerwah. During search, officers recovered 13 Kg Poppy Straw from their possession. Meanwhile in Pulwama, a Police Party of Police Station Litter at a checkpoint established at Achan intercepted two suspects identified as Mohd Altaf Dar, son of Gh Mohd Dar & Tariq Ahmad Dar, son of Ali Mohd Dar, both residents of Achan Pulwama. During search, 1 Kg Charas Powder was recovered from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to respective Police Stations where they remained in custody. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections was registered in respective police stations and investigations started. Meanwhile, a Party of Police Post Putkha at a checkpoint established at Putkha Muqam intercepted one Tariq Ahmad Dar, son of Ghulam Ahmad Dar, resident of Sikh Mohalla, Najibkhana, Baramulla. During search, 30 gm Heroin was recovered from his possession. Consequently, FIR No. 104/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Tarzoo and investigation started.
