JAMMU: Professionalism is buzzword in Jammu and Kashmir Cricket Association (JKCA) and the game of cricket is unquestionably on the rise, which can be gauged from the fact that Jammu and Kashmir Senior Men's team created history on Wednesday by qualifying for the knockout stage for the first time in the prestigious Vijay Hazare Trophy and is also in sight of qualification in the ongoing Men's U-25 State A Trophy. It may be recalled that J&K U-19 Men's team qualified for the knockout phase in Vinoo Mankad Trophy this season and Senior Women's team also made it to the historic knockout stage last season.

The performance of various teams speaks of fairness, transparency and professionalism in the system. JK cricketers showed that champions never sleep, the eternal spirit keep them alert and awake.

Meanwhile, J&K defeated Uttarakhand in an easy contest at Wankhede Stadium today to make it five wins out of six matches at league stage in Vijay Hazare Trophy to qualify for the knockout stage, while J&K got the better of formidable Vidharbha in a thrilling contest in U-25 State A Trophy by 3 wickets at Saurashtra Cricket Association Stadium Rajkot.

In reply, J&K chased the target in a thrilling contest in 49.5 overs by losing 7 wickets to win the match by 3 wickets. Jiyaad Nazir Magrey top scored with 59 runs off 64 balls including 7 fours and 2 sixes, while Dikshant Kundal and skipper Kanhaiya Wadhawan contributed 45 and 41 runs to the total respectively. Lone Nasir Muzaffar and Kawal Preet Singh also contributed valuable 22 and unbeaten 20 runs to the total respectively. For Vidharbha, Aditya Khilote took 4 wickets, while Preerit Agrawal bagged 3 wickets.

The U-25 team is being accompanied by former First

D Negi made brisk 52 off 48 balls including 6 boundaries. ## JNV Leh Parents' Association seeks LAHDC's intervention for heating facility as students suffer from frostbite

LEH: Chairman/CEC, LAHDC, Leh Tashi Gyalson was called upon by a delegation consisting of parents of students studying in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV), Leh.

The parents' delegation apprised CEC of several issues concerning the need for school infrastructure upgradation required at the school.

"As you are well aware of the fact that the best of the brains from different parts of Ladakh are studying in JNV Leh, and academically this school is always known for its extraordinary performances. However, the students in the school and hostel have to face multitudes of problems, including lack of heating facilities, in pursuing their education. We, the representatives of parents of JNV students, would like to seek your kind intervention to immediately arrange a heating facility in the hostel and provide glass rooms to cover the southsides of the single storeyed hostel rooms," the delegation of the parents requested. They informed that many

students in the JNV Leh school are suffering from frost-bites due to lack of any heating system in the hostel.

"The school hostels have been built in such a way that is completely not suitable for Ladakh's climatic condition. Therefore, we request you to immediately provide some heating facilities for the hostel rooms. We propose that all single storeyed hostel buildings, which are south faced, be immediately covered with glass rooms, either with aluminum frame or wooden," the delegation suggested.

Parents' representatives also requested CEC, LAHDC, Leh to intervene to depute/post an officer, preferably a Ladakhii, as its Principal/Administrator as would be easier for a local

officer to supervise the school, and its situations since he/she would be better acquainted with problems being faced by local students. CEC was informed about the pathetic condition of toilets and bathrooms and requested to work out a mechanism to keep them clean and hygiene in a systematic and scientific way. Cleanliness of the hostel rooms, bathrooms, and the premises of the school has always been an issue and therefore parents requested that a Municipal Committee truck be sent to the school to collect garbage on a weekly basis.

Taking note of their grievances, CEC Gyalson assured to take up the matters with the concerned authorities for early redressal.
