

Dulloo reviews status-of micro irrigation & irrigation for Kharif 2023

JAMMU: Additional Chief Secretary (ACS), Agriculture Production Department, Atal Dulloo, on Friday chaired a meeting of senior officers to review status of micro irrigation and irrigation for Kharif 2023 at Civil Secretariat Jammu.

Principal Secretary, Jal Shakti, Shaleen Kabra was also present in the meeting.

The meeting discussed various issues related to Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), Micro Irrigation Fund (MIF) for three years and other irrigation related issues faced by the farmers in Jammu and Kashmir besides, Budget Estimate plan for 2023-2024.

Director, APD, Kashmir briefed the meeting about component wise activities of various allied departments and Ministries prior 2022, proposed annual action plan under Per Drop More Crop

(PDMC) component of PMKSY for the year 2022-23. The meeting was informed that the PMKSY scheme was launched by the government of India in 2015 with the objective of convergence of investments in irrigation, enhance access to irrigation and adoption of precision-irrigation, improved on-farm water use efficiency, water conservation and ground water recharge and extension activities.

Atal Dulloo directed the officers of concerned depart-

ments to ensure desilting of canals to make them functional by 1st March in Jammu division and 1st April in Kashmir division. He also asked them to ensure that water reach at the tail end of the canals in every village in Jammu and Kashmir.

ACS directed the Directors of Agriculture Jammu and Kashmir to prepare a irrigation schedule with the assistance of CEs Irrigation, FC Jammu and Kashmir in consultation with Rural Development department. He

said that the schedule will help the water users especially the farming community.

Chief Engineers Irrigation and Directors of APD of both the divisions were directed to formulate a project proposal for Udhampur and Baramulla districts under PM Gati Shakti scheme. If the projects are thrown open successfully then the same projects shall be replicated to other districts of Union Territory so that more and more areas brought under irrigation in these districts. Director Agriculture Jammu, K K Sharma; Director Horticulture, Jammu, Ram Savak; Director CAD Jammu, Rajinder Singh Tara; Chief Engineer, I&FC Jammu and other concerned officers were present in the meeting besides Director Agriculture Kashmir, Iqbal Choudhary, and other senior officers of Agriculture and allied Departments participated through virtual mode.

JAMMU: A delegation of All J&K Plus Two Lecturers' Forum, comprising R S Slathia (Chairman), Pardeep Singh Rakwal (Provincial President), Dr Ashok Sharma (Vice President), Ghar Singh Saini (General Secretary), Kamal Lal (Chief Organiser) and others called on Principal Secretary, School Education Department, Alok Kumar in Jammu. The delegation submitted a copy of memorandum enlisting points to be incorporated in Gazetted School Education (Service Rules) like creation of Vice Principal post in pay level 10-A (5600), enhancing pay level of Principals, Time bound Promotion (in-situ) to 10+2 cadre, allocation of Non-vocational status to Principals etc.

The delegation also highlighted various pending demands of plus two cadre

including filling up of all vacant posts of Principals, regularization of all Incharge incumbents, restoration of 40 per cent college quota in favour of plus two cadre, repatriation of officers working in hard zones, opening of sub offices of JK BOSE in remote areas, allotment of home districts to Principals and Lecturers serving at verge of retirement, continuation of ATD in next session too, induction into KAS after completing 14 years of service as lecturer, etc.

Drug Control Deptt conducts massive checking drive in Jammu

(Retailers as well as Wholesalers) for determination of strength and purity.

These samples were referred to Drug Testing Laboratories for framing legal opinion to ascertain their quality parameters.

Moreover, procurement records of pharmaceutical preparations were put on scrutiny to ensure that drug formulations are being purchased from regulated channels only. The Pharma Trade Fraternity was impressed upon to ensure that the drugs shall only be procured from the authorized stockist through regulated channels, to ensure that spurious /not of standard quality drugs don't find entry in the market through unscrupulous /clandestine channels.

During the drive,

Operations of Eight Drug Sale Establishments were disallowed u/s 22 (d) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 for violation of conditions of the licenses. The Licenses were warned of severe action in case the deficiencies are not removed within a stipulated period of time. Moreover, Acting swiftly on the inputs that a Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadi Kendra being run inside a prominent Public Institution in Jammu City is selling some pharmaceutical preparations other than that of Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI), immediate action was taken and operations of the Kendra were disallowed to give a loud and clear message to all Jan Aushdhi kendras , that they would not be allowed to

defeat the noble cause of this pro public and pro patent initiative of providing Jan Aushadi medicines at affordable prices to the general public.

Operations of a Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadi Kendra have also been disallowed as the said Kendra was found to be indulged in sale of drug formulations other than the permitted ones.

Lotika Khajuria, State Drug Controller has once again impressed upon the trade fraternity to procure drug formulations from regulated channels only and sell the pharmaceutical preparations against the prescription of RMPs only and as per advisories issued from time to time , failing which strict action as contemplated under rules shall be initiated against the defaulters.

This is to inform all the Industrial Units that the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Government of India has announced New Central Sector Scheme for Industrial Development of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir vide Notification No. F. No. 1(1)/2020-SSS dated: 19.02.2021. In this context, it is requested to all the eligible New and Existing Units to apply online (www.jknis.dpit.gov.in) for grant of registration under the scheme to avail the Incentives envisaged under the scheme.

Some Salient features of this scheme are mentioned as under:-

Capital Investment Incentive(CII):-

New units and Existing units undertaking substantial expansion with investment of not more than Rs.50.00(Fifty) crore in Plant & Machinery(for manufacturing sector) or Building and all otherdurable physical assets (for service sector) will be eligible to avail this incentive in b oth Zone A and Zone B at the rate of 30% & 50% in Zone A & Zone B respectively on Plant & Machinery (for manufacturing sector) or Building and all other durable physical assets (for service sector).

Capital Interest Subvention (CIS):-

New units and Existing units undertaking substantial expansion are eligible for this incentive on the loan availed on investment made in eligible plant and machinery (for manufacturing sector), or construction of building and other durable physical assets (for service sector) at the rate of 06% for maximum period of 07 (Seven) consecutive years.

Goods & Services Tax Linked Incentive(GSTLI):-

New units registered under the scheme irrespective of the value of investment in plant and machinery (for manufacturing sector) and construction of building and other durable physical assets (for service sector) and having a GST registration will be eligible for benefit under this incentive maximum at the rate of 300% of the eligible value of investment made in plant and machinery (for manufacturing sector) or construction of building and other durable physical assets (for services sector).


Working Capital Interest Subvention(WCIS):-

All existing units in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir registered under GST prior to the date of notification of this scheme will be eligible for this incentive at the rate of 5% on working capital loan for maximum period of 05(Five) consecutive years from the date of grant of registration subject to theregistration and other conditions as detailed in the guidelines.
