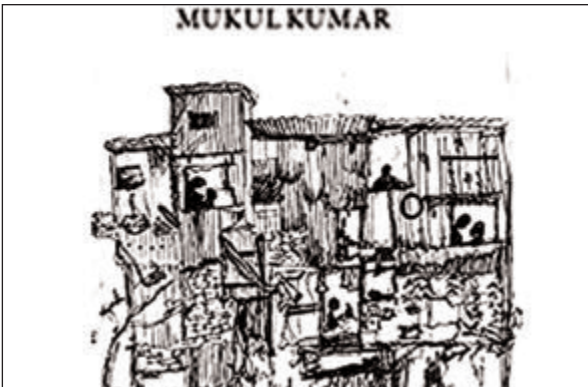
REVIEW: Even though a comedy, the movie tries to break gender biases. Deep refuses to kiss Sukh before they are married, not because he's conservative but because he will consider society truly broadminded when it's as forgiving of women as it's of men for their bold behaviour. Sukh also makes them realise that a daughter-in-law must not be burdened with chores when she's as tired as the rest of the family. Deep is portrayed as a thoughtful man who doesn't flinch from asking for forgiveness and almost begging Sukh's parents to bring her back home when unjust treatment makes her walk out. Her father poignantly states that this must be the first time the groom stands in front of the bride's parents with folded hands.

Jasmin shines as the simple and kind Sukh and is pleasing to the eye. She and Gippy, who also performs well, have great on-screen chemistry. The entire star cast, including Karamjit Anmol as Deep's chacha, will keep you entertained.

Even though the premise of naive and loud villagers landing in England is not entirely new, and some of the serious scenes are a bit soppy, the direction and performances make this laugh riot worth watching.
