

Judicial Academy organises workshop, special skill enhancement training programme for Civil Judges of Jammu

JAMMU: To commemorate the spirit of Constitution on the occasion of Constitution Day, J&K Judicial Academy under the patronage of Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey, Chief Justice, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, (Patron-in-Chief, J&K Judicial Academy), on Saturday organized one day workshop and special skill enhancement training programme on "Leadership role of the Judge in Court Management including Case and Time Management, Managing Stress; Canons of Judicial Ethics and Behavior; Bangalore Principles of Judicial Conduct, Code of Conduct, Qualities of a Judge, Communication skills and Personality development" for Civil Judges (Senior and Junior division) of Jammu Province at Judicial Academy, Jammu. The event was organized under the guidance of Justice Sindhu Sharma, Chairperson, Governing Committee for J&K Judicial Academy and Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul, Justice Javed Iqbal Wani and Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal besides members of Governing Committee for J&K Judicial Academy.

Justice Sindhu Sharma inaugurated the training programme in presence of Justice Rahul Bharti, Judge, High Court of J&K and Ladakh, who was also the resource person for the workshop.


In the inaugural session, Justice Rahul Bharti, in his special remarks described the judicial officers as mainstay of the entire judicial system and emphasised the important role of district judiciary as torch bearers of the administration of justice system. He also called upon the judicial officers to discharge their duties with utmost sincerity and commitment.

In her inaugural address, Justice Sindhu Sharma emphasized the qualities of compassion, performance of duty and impartiality as being the hallmark of judicial conduct which must be of impeccable character. She

exhorted the judicial officers to ensure that the cause of justice should not suffer. She described the legal profession as a divine duty and called upon the judicial officers to exhibit the highest standards of ethics, compassion and courteousness in their professional conduct since they are at the first interface with the public. Director, J&K Judicial Academy, Shahzad Azeem, presented the welcome

address and gave an overview of the programme. He said that the judges being at the pivot of the temple of justice must exhibit the highest standards of personal and professional conduct and must inspire the trust and confidence of people through his ability and efficacy. He also referred to the qualitative traits of civility, integrity, honesty and discernment as being integral for the holistic achievement of justice.

In order to check / prevent / stop illicit use of HABIT FORMING DRUGS (Alprazolam, Tramadol, Codeine, Tapentadol, Diazepam., clonazepam, Phenobarbital, Pentazocin Inj., Ketamine inj., Nitrazepam, & allied preparations) in any generic or branded generic or branded form, single ingredient or Fixed Dose Combinations, the pharma trade fraternity is impressed upon to strictly follow the below checklist:

Do's

★★★★

- ✓ The prescription must not be dispensed more than once unless the prescriber has stated thereon that it may be dispensed more than once. Name and quantity of medicine supplied, Name and address of the patient, prescription date and name and address of the prescriber be clearly mentioned on the prescription.
- ✓ All records and registers shall be maintained as per mandate of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 & Rules thereunder. Such records should be made available for inspection.
- ✓ Chemists should install HD CCTV / Computerized billing system in their respective establishments.
- ✓ The records of Schedule H , H1 and X drugs shall be preserved by the licensee for a period of two years.

Don't

★★★★

- X Dispense medication if the prescription is incomplete, has alteration(s) or does not bear signatures of the prescriber (Registered Medical Practitioner).
- X Dispense psychotropic drugs to minors.
- X Dispense a prescription when you have reason to believe that prescription is not issued by a valid prescriber.
- X Disclose the personal information of the end user /prescriber.

The department has decided to adopt a zero tolerance approach to counter unregulated sale of HABIT FORMING DRUGS in the larger interest of a drug free society.



In case any pharma trader indulges in willful omission / breach with respect to purchase / sale of HABIT FORMING DRUGS, the drug sale license's of such dealers shall be cancelled.
