JAMMU: Spokesperson BJP, Abhijeet Jasrotia said that politicians need to be pragmatic. Those who cried foul are speechless now as the upgraded final list of voters shows a total of 83,59,771 voters which include 42,91,687 male 40,67,900 female & 184 transgenders. He further said that all those who gave 25 lakh data of new voters & those who played politics on this all are speechless. "The moment this misinformation was given opposition was on its toes but no one realised that an erstwhile state in past 5 decades could not even reach a crore, how is it possible to add 25 lakh voters in 5 years. The villagers said that a stone crusher in the name of Gulam Nabi Mir is coming up in the residential area of their village for which no NOC (No Objection Certificate) was obtained from the Mangnar Panchayat or residents of the village.

They said that there are two schools, Govt High School and Govt Middle School in the near vicinity of the proposed site at a distance of not more than 250 meters besides an ancient Mandir (religious place). They said that the

dust emanated out of this crusher would be most hazardous to the health of students and the devotees visiting Mandir. They also said that they are at a loss to understand as to how the authorities including the local bodies, pollution control board, Geology and Mining can give consent to the upcoming stone crusher. The villagers and their Panchayat members have appealed to the Deputy Commissioner Poonch to issue directions to Gulam

Nabi Mir to stop construction of Crusher without any delay else they will be left with no option but to intensify their protests.
