JAMMU: Director Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare, Jammu, K. K. Sharma on Monday inaugurated the Shiitake Mushroom Cultivation and training Center CSKHPKV, Palampur for multi-location trials at Directorate of Agriculture, Jammu.

"After the trials and standardization of all the parameters, the cultivation technique of Shiitake Mushroom will be transferred to farmer level within one year. This initiative will provide farmers an opportunity for round the year cultivation of Mushroom with enhanced returns," the Director added. Joint Director (Inputs), A. S. Reen; Agriculture Chemist, Aman Jyoti; Agriculture Economist, Jog Raj Salathia; Spawn Production officer, Krishan Kant Gupta; Mushroom Production officer, Snajay Dhar; Assistant Agriculture Chemist, Pradeep Sharma, besides other officers were present on the occasion.

said. Further, it was informed that the 20 Shiitake Mushroom blocks have been procured from Shiitake Cultivation and training Center CSKHPKV, Palampur for multi-location trials at Directorate of Agriculture, Jammu.

"Shiitake Mushroom (Lentinula edodes) is the world's second most cultivated mushroom, containing medicinal qualities against depressed immune function, cancer, AIDS, environmental allergies and frequent flu and colds. Speaking on the occasion, the Director Agriculture said that a successful trial of spawn production and cultivation of Shiitake Mushroom is already being carried out in Spawners Production Laboratory, Jammu. The cultivation trial is being carried out on Sawdust of broad leaves in polypropylene bags as per the guidelines of Directorate of Mushroom Research (ICAR), Solan, he

In pursuance of Notification No.089-BOPEE of 2022 dated 22-01-2022, the second round of counselling (physical) for upgradation/allotment of seats was held on 24-11-2022 & 25-11-2022, the list of candidates who have been upgraded/allotted seats provisionally for undergoing MBBS/BDS Courses 2022 in various Government / Private Medical / Dental Colleges of UT of J&K, is hereby notified as per Annexure "A" to this notification which shall be available on website of the Board: [www.jkbopee.gov.in](http://www.jkbopee.gov.in) only. The candidates shall report to the colleges allotted to them w.e.f. 26-11-2022 to 29-11-2022 (upto 04:00 P.M.) along with necessary documents including the following for admission:-

1. Date of Birth Certificate
2. Marks Card of 10+2.
3. Domicile Certificate of UT of J&K and for the candidates of UT of Ladakh, ST certificate issued by the Competent authority of Ladakh shall be treated as domicile certificate.
4. Category certificate, if any
5. Valid Income Certificate of P&B category candidates
6. HM Certificate/ document, whenever applicable.
7. Any other certificate demanded by the College Authorities

The concerned Colleges shall keep their admission counters open even on holidays/ off days and designate Nodal Officers to facilitate the candidates in the process of admission. However, the candidates should, in their own interest, avoid waiting for the last day to complete the admission formalities as such delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.

The Colleges shall submit the shortfall, if any, by 29th of November, 2022 upto 05.00 P.M. positively to enable the Board to take further necessary action in the matter.

#### Note:-

1. As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of UT of J&K & Ladakh vide order dated:15.11.2022 in WPC No.776/2022, one seat of MBBS (Female) in CDP Category has been kept reserved.
2. The admission of the candidates is purely provisional and shall be liable to be cancelled in case any information furnished by any candidate proves to be false/ fabricated, and action as warranted under law shall be initiated against such candidates.
3. It is hereby implored upon the management of all Colleges / Institutions to ensure the veracity of documents, particularly the category certificates, wherever the admission is to be granted in lieu of particular reserved category. So, far as the persons with disability are concerned, if selected in Open merit or reserved category, it shall be ensured that his/her PwD Certificate/eligibility is in conformity with NMC/DCI guidelines, regulations framed by the regulatory authority & wherever required shall refer the matter to Medical Board to assess such candidates and make recommendations based on which institution shall take further necessary action. In case any candidate does not fulfill the benchmarks of eligibility as per NMC/DCI guidelines, he/she shall not be admitted to the course/institute.
4. The Heads of the Institutions/ Colleges are requested to release the documents and fee to the candidates who have been upgraded during this round of counselling without wasting their time to enable them to report to the upgraded colleges by or before 28-11-2022.
5. The other terms and conditions shall remain the same as notified by the Board in e-Information Brochure/ Notifications/ Notices issued from time to time on the subject.

Consequent upon declaration of the NEET UG- 2022 result by the National Testing Agency on 17-07-2022, and to update the category status vis a vis preparation of the Provisional UT Merit List of registered candidates for admission to Ayush (BAMS/BUMS&BPT courses 2022, it is hereby notified that the candidates who have secured the minimum qualifying marks in NEET UG -2022 and have not registered earlier shall register themselves for these courses and upload the following documents with effect from 30-11-2022 to 06-12-2022:-

- (i) NEET -UG score card 2022
- (ii) 10+2 marks card.
- (iii) Domicile Certificate of UT of J&K (ST Category Certificate in respect of candidates belonging to the UT of Ladakh).
- (iv) Category Certificate, wherever required.
- (v) Date of Birth Certificate (Matriculation).

#### The cut-off score for different categories as notified by NTA is as under:-

- a. Open Merit (including JKPM/child of PMF/CDP/Sports/ EWS) : 117
- b. Open Merit (Physically Handicapped/PWD) : 105
- c. SC/ST/RBA/ALC/IB/OSC/PSB (for J&K/Ladakh): 93
- d. SC/ST/RBA/ALC/IB/OSC/PSB(Physically Handicapped/PWD) : 93

The tentative NEET Score list of candidates of J&K, who have appeared in the NEET UG 2022 has already been notified by the Board vide Notification No.065-BOPEE of 2022 dated 29-09-2022 and Notice No 026-BOPEE of 2022 dated 05-10-2022, which are available on the BOPEE website viz [www.jkbopee.gov.in](http://www.jkbopee.gov.in) only.

Mobile phones should not be used for registration purposes for uploading of documents, as software will not accept the same.

The e-Information Brochure for NEET UG & AYUSH Courses (BAMS/BUMS & BPT) 2022 has already been uploaded on website of the Board.

As conveyed by the Health and Medical Education Department, J&K vide letter No. ME-Gztd/193/2022 dated 22-09-2022 the 15% All India Quota seats in Govt/Pvt. Colleges are surrendered to All India Quota (AIQ) and as per guidelines issued by Ministry of Ayush, GOI, the State / UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for 15% of AIQ UG & PG seats under Private ASU&H Colleges and Institutions / Private State Universities (Other than Deemed Universities). It is hereby notified for information of all eligible candidates applying for Ayush courses that 15% of AIQ seats of following Private Colleges reserved both for BAMS/BUMS are to be filled by State/UT counselling authority i.e J&K BOPEE.
