CRIME REPORT

Theft in five shops at Samba

SAMBA: Thieves tried to target five shops near the main square of Samba city, but were able to succeed only in two shops, while leaving only the locks of three shops.



At the same time, the police registered the case and started action. According to the information, the thieves managed to steal cash and goods worth Rs 10,000 from a grocery store and Rs 4,000 from a hardware shop late at night.

After this, the thieves went to target some shops in front of the vegetable market and broke the locks of three shops there, but did not steal the goods. On the other hand, when the shop owners came to know about this in the morning, the Samba police were informed and the police reached the spot, collected evidence, registered a case and started action.

Narwal arms recovery case: Duo grilled by JIC for a week

JAMMU: Two accused, who were nabbed with consignment of arms in Narwal, were interrogated in JIC for a week and were again brought back to police station. The report of the inquiry has not yet been sent to police. It is being told that a team has moved to Kashmir after getting clues from them so that their links can be ascertained.

According to the information, Narwal police recovered weapons from a tanker after which tanker-owner Farooq Ahmed, resident Darangbal and driver, Mohammad Yasin were arrested. A minor was also caught along with them who is son of owner, and was sent to Juvenile Home. The remaining two were interrogated at police station. Many things came to light during interrogation, from which it came to fore that driver Yasin wanted to become a terrorist and for

this he was carrying weapons. After interrogation by police, both were sent to JIC where they were interrogated for almost a week. Now, JIC will officially give report of inquiry.

Two arrested with banned syrup

Woman nabbed with 50 pouches of illicit liquor

KATHUA: In continuation to drive against illicit liquor menace launched by Kathua Police on the directions of SSP R C Kotwal, on Tuesday a woman was nabbed with 50 pouches (180 ml each) of illicit liquor at Keerian area. She was been identified as Preeti, wife of Ashok Kumar, resident of Chak Drab Khan Tehsil & District Kathua.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Lakhampur led by PSI Mansoor Ahmed under supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh & Insp Vijay Kotwal SHO Lakhampur during patrolling duty at Keerian area apprehended a woman who was selling/transportation of illicit liquor (Desi Liquor) to people. During search, 50 pouches (180 ml each) of illicit liquor thereby making a total of approximately 12 lts Desi liquor was seized from her possession. She was arrested and FIR 96/2022 under section 48 (A) Excise Act was registered at Police Station Lakhampur.

Missing girl traced, reunited with family

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday traced a missing girl and reunited with her family.

As per details, information was received at Police Post Chinore, by legal heirs of a girl stating that she went missing from her house. In this regard, missing report was registered on November 24, 2022 and investigation started. On this, a team of Police Post Chinore formed under supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Domana Insp Tilak Raj assisted by Incharge Police Post Chinore PSI Rajesh Kumar, after putting in hectic efforts, traced the missing girl. Subsequently, her family was informed and she was handed over to her family after completing all legal formalities.

6 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which team of Police Station Nagrota and Border Police Post Chakroi acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicle included two tractor-trolleys without registration number seized by Nagrota police and two tractor-trolleys bearing Chassis numbers 006505430C1 and 100060046E seized by Chakroi Police. The recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Insp Vishav Partap Singh and Incharge Border Police Post Chakroi PSI Ishfaq Ahmed Kasana in their respective jurisdictions.

Meanwhile, a police team headed by Insp O P Chib SHO Kathua under supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammi Kumar during patrolling/checking duty in its jurisdictional area at Berrian Pattan Naka seized a truck indulged in illegal mining. While in second instance police led by PSI Ravinder Thakur Incharge Police Post Nagri under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammi Kumar during Naka checking in its jurisdictional area at Pandori area, seized a Tractor along with trolley indulged in illegal transportation of construction material. The said vehicles indulged in illegal mining were seized & immediately handed over to officials of Geological and Mining Department, Kathua for further legal proceedings.

Theft case solved; thief arrested, stolen cash & jewellery recovered

ARNIA: Police on Tuesday solved a theft case by arresting a thief and recovered jewellery and cash. As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Arnia by one Subash Chander, son of Dhawan Chand, resident of Arnia stating that when he went to temple, he saw locks broken and cash as well as other jewellery stolen from temple. On receipt of information, FIR No. 111/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Arnia under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Arnia Insp Deepak Katoch, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect later identified as Ajay Kumar, son of Joginder Kumar alias Pappu, resident of Arnia. During intensive questioning, accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure stolen cash and jewellery was recovered from his possession.

Drug-peddler arrested, contraband recovered

BARAMULLA: Continuing efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, police on Tuesday arrested a drug-peddler in Baramulla and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per the details, a party led by SHO Police Station Kunzer under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg Hilal Khaliq, during routine patrolling in village Hardshura Kunzer intercepted a suspect identified as Farooq Ahmad Mir, son of Ghulam Mohi-ud-Din Mir, resident of Zaspura Tangmarg. During search, 18 sticks of Charas like substance wrapped in maize peelings weighing about 500 gm and cash amounting to Rs 6,000 were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Kunzer and investigation started.
