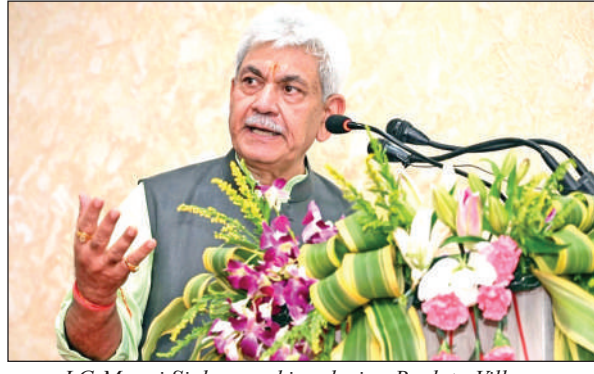
# Days of indiscretion, arbitrariness over: LG
