UDHAMPUR: A meeting was convened under the chairmanship of by All J&K Gaddi Sabha Youth President Kuldeep Kumar at Udhampur in which burning issues faced by the community were discussed.

Main issue highlighted in the meeting was of recommendation for the inclusion of some ethnic groups in the ST status by G.D. Sharma

commission including Pahari. But the inclusion of Pahari people in the ST category is beyond comprehension on the following basis, firstly, its identification, proper specification, and isolation from non Pahari people, secondly does these people properly qualify for ST status full filling all the required criteria for being tribe, thirdly what about the people of other districts residing in

the upper reaches of Doda, Udhampur, Kathua.

In meeting unanimous it was decided to appeal to UT Govt as well as the central Govt that while including the other ethnic groups 10% quota of Gaddi and Sipis should not be affected. He added that a favourable, justifiable, unbiased mechanism will be devised, while dispensing the social justice for other ethnic groups without dis-

turbing the already given status to the Gaddis and Sipis. Community members from Kathua, Bhaderwah, Ramtan, Udhampur and Billawar participated in the meeting.
