JAMMU: All J&K Passengers' Welfare Association (AJKPWA) held a meeting under the leadership of its president Pt R.C Sharma expressed shock and grief over the recent accident in which 39 passengers killed and 17 injured, whereas accused the government for deliberately ignoring frequent occurrence of the road accidents in J&K, which clearly indicates the failure of UT adminis-

Besides, demanded to constitute a higher level 'Reasons Finding Committee of Road Accidents and its Prevention' headed by Chief Secretary. While addressing a meeting, RC

Sharma said that UT government must open its eyes over the frequent occurring of road accidents as it is the prime duty and responsibility of the UT administra-

He said that roads have been converted into slaughtering machines and the vehicles are being taken as feeders.
