Rana reviews water supply in Jammu division

JAMMU: "In preparation for the winters and more migrations in Jammu division during the season, the Jal Shakti Department has geared up its men and machinery to serve the people with added accountability and responsibility", stated Minister for Jal Shakti, Forest, Ecology & Environment and Tribal Affairs, Javed Ahmed Rana, during a review meeting of the department held at Civil Secretariat here on Monday.

Chief Engineer, Hamesh Manchanda informed the Minister that the department is providing adequate and safe drinking water supply across the Jammu province. He added that all the Circle and Divisional offices are focusing on enhancing service delivery and infrastructure readiness to meet increased demand during the winter period.

The Chief Engineer highlighted proactive measures being initiated to address the increased water requirements while maintaining rigorous quality standards. The major initiatives discussed during the meeting included enhanced water supply preparedness. It was informed that water reservoirs across the province have been checked and filled to maximum capacity to support supply, especially during peak usage hours. The Minister directed the officers to maintain and repair the Borewells and Handpumps in Pir Panjal area. He exhorted upon them to inspect all their respective areas where any deficiency of water supply is being reported.

Rana also enquired about the unauthorised installation of handpumps in many areas without approval from the authority. He asked for initiating a detailed enquiry into the matter. Javed Rana

directed the concerned to speed up pace of progress on all ongoing works for timely completion.

He further directed for re-tendering of some of the specific works in view of certain irregularities.

Javed Rana directed the Chief Engineer for providing a district wise detail of areas of Jammu province facing shortage of water supply. He asked for keeping the emergency repair teams standby to respond promptly to any emergent situation.

JAMMU: Advising the NC president Dr. Farooq Abdullah to go public with proper homework, Jammu and Kashmir BJP president & former minister, Sat Sharma, said that the former Chief Minister is trying to mislead the people of Jammu by leveling false charges against BJP. He should seek apology from the people of Jammu for his act. Sat Sharma was addressing a group of party activists from Poonch at party headquarter, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu. He said that the

recent allegation of Dr. Farooq Abdullah that BJP lacks concern for Jammu is totally false and misleading. He said that being in politics does not mean one can utter anything without knowing the facts. Making false statements /charges, is not a sign of healthy politics and it raises questions on the credibility of those leaders who indulge in such practices. Sat Sharma reminded that it has been BJP only which was on forefront for

real concern for Jammu in all matters and at all levels, while NC discriminated with Jammu and its people right from 50s.

"While Jammu got adequate share in the schemes and programmes of the BJP government under PM Narendra Modi, Kashmir too has been treated equal", Sat said, adding that discrimination with Jammu has ended during the past over ten years. Dr. Farooq Abdullah must know that

Jammu got AIIMS, Central University, IIT, IIM, Ring Road, Smart City and Ropeway Projects, besides modernization of Jammu railway station, upgradation of Jammu Airport etc under BJP government, Sat said. Refugees from West Pakistan, were denied citizenship rights only because they had settled in Jammu and it was only BJP which heard their cries and granted them all the rights similar to other citi-

zens of the country. The Valmikis and Gorkhas of Jammu too got justice from BJP and are leading dignified lives today.

The BJP president asked the party activists in the meeting to reach the masses and expose Dr. Farooq Abdullah for his misleading campaign against BJP. He also appealed to the people of Jammu not to get misled by what Dr. Farooq Abdullah has said.
