Q: You have covered the G20 Summit in India, the G7 Summit in Italy, and now the G20 in Brazil. What are your thoughts on this summit?

Natasha: This G20 summit is highly significant. Issues such as climate change, hunger eradication, and gender equality were key topics of discussion, and there was notable consensus among the participating nations. However, ongoing global conflicts, such as the Ukraine-Russia war and the Israel-Gaza war, continue to hinder progress, making advancements slow.

Q: G20 summit in Delhi was considered a major success,

Natasha: Food security remains one of the most pressing challenges for South-South cooperation.
