Dist Level Training Program on Soil Health Management concludes

JAMMU: Divisional Soil Survey Scheme under the Directorate of Agriculture Production and Farmer's Welfare Jammu organized a Ztraining Programme on Soil Health Management at Batote. As many as 50 Farmers/Rural Youth of District Ramban participated in the workshop which concluded on Thursday. The Training Programme was part of the series of District Level training programs being convened under Capacity Building Component of IADP Project 19 J&K Soil and Land Resources Information Systems for Planning and Soil Health Management (JKSLRD) for the Year 2024-25. On the first day, the programme commenced by lighting of traditional lamp by DDC member Batote Jagbir Das in presence of Divisional Soil Survey Officer Jammu, and other dignitaries. The resource persons gave detailed presentations on judicious use of Fertilizers, Sustainable Soil Health Management, Physical Properties of Soils, Soil Health Card Scheme, Land Capability Classification and Integrated Nutrient Management. DSSO Jammu Suresh Kumar Khajuria, Scientist RHRS Bhaderwah Dr Sanjeev Choudhary; DAO Extension Ramban Ravi Sharma; Assistant Soil Chemist Jammu Dr Neeraj Rajwal; ASSO Jammu Dr Aadil Rashid; and SCA Vikramjeet Singh were the resource persons. The programme culminated with the distribution of participation certificates and Soil Sample collection Kits among the participants.

Advisory for Parents of Minor/Underage Drivers

Time and again Motor Vehicles Department has advised the parents against allowing their Minor/ Underage children to drive two wheelers/four wheelers. Recently a number of instances where Juveniles are diving two/ four wheelers with impunity particularly in Srinagar & Jammu cities have been reported. This not only puts the lives of these minor children at risk but also poses a threat to the pedestrians as well as to other commuters. This is a serious offence, which can attract punitive action against the offenders under section 199A of the Motor vehicles Act, 1988.

"The guardian or owner shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years and with a fine of twenty- five thousand rupees. Further in case of any offence under MV act 1988 has been committed by the juvenile, the guardian of such juvenile or the owner of the motor vehicle shall be deemed to be guilty of the contravention and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly. In addition, the registration of the motor vehicle used in commission of the offence shall be cancelled... The juvenile shall not be eligible to be granted a driving license under section 9 or a learner's license under section 8 until such juvenile has attained the age of twenty-five years. For the offences under the MV act the juvenile shall be punishable with such fines as provided by the Act while any custodial sentence may be modified as per the provisions of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2000 (56 of 2000)."

Hence again through the medium of this advisory the general public especially the parents/ guardians of the minors are requested to desist from the practice of allowing their minor children to drive two/ four wheelers, as the same is a serious offence and punishable under law.

1. **Examination Fee:**

After successful submission of the online application form, candidates have to pay the fee through online mode only in the "Submitted Applications" Menu @ Rs.400/- per paper.

2. **Centre of Examination:**

- The Examination will be held at J&K PSC Examination Hall, Srinagar and J&K PSC Examination Hall, Jammu.
- The allotment of centres shall be at the sole discretion of the Commission and once a centre is allotted to a candidate, request for change of centre will neither be entertained nor will the Commission respond to request for change of centre.

Notes:

- The Candidate should carefully mention about his/her choice for the centre viz. Jammu/Srinagar and the Papers he wants to appear in the examination while filling up the Online Application Form.
- The necessary instructions regarding filling up of online applications are given herein below:-
 - Candidates are required to apply online through the website of the Commission i.e <http://www.jkpsc.nic.in>. No other means/ mode of application shall be accepted.
 - Candidates are first required to go to the JKPS website www.jkpsc.nic.in and click on the link "One Time Registration" or click on Login menu if you have already created your profile with the JK PSC.
 - After logging into your account, candidates are required to fill all the requisite fields of One Time Registration (OTR) i.e. personal information, contact information & educational qualification, service details and uploading of documents etc.
 - The candidate shall also be required to upload the images of recent photograph and signature. Photograph image must mention the date in which it is taken.

- e) Size of the photograph (passport size) and signature must be between 10kB to 20kB in *.jpeg or *.jpg only.

f) After successful submission of all the details in your OTR account, check the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the advertisement notification before applying for the post.

g) Click on the "show jobs" as shown against the respective post/examination you want to apply.

h) On Clicking on the "show jobs" a window will appear on your computer screen. Select the month of the advertisement notification for which you want to apply, a link(s) for the post(s) will appear on the computer screen.

i) An "APPLY" button is shown against the respective post and the candidates will click on the APPLY button against the post he/she is eligible.

j) On clicking "APPLY" button, an instruction window will appear. Candidates should read instructions carefully before clicking on "APPLY" button at the bottom of the webpage.

k) On clicking "APPLY" button, the system will display all facts/particulars that a candidate have mentioned while filling up the necessary fields of his/her OTR account.

l) Once the candidate is satisfied about the filled in details, then, he or she may click on "SUBMIT" button to finally push the data into server with successful submission report, which he or she can print.
