JAMMU: A scintillating century by Shantul Raina guided the University of Jammu into the semifinals of the ongoing Vice Chancellor's T-20 Cricket Tournament at LUVAS University, Hisar. Riding on Shantul's explosive 145, the University of Jammu registered a commanding 73-run victory over Panjab University, Chandigarh.

Battling first, the University of Jammu posted a mammoth total of 234 runs in the allotted 20 overs. Shantul Raina was the star of the innings, smashing 15 towering sixes and seven fours in his 145-run blitz. He received valuable support from Vishal (30), Rajesh (28), and Sandeep (23), helping the team build an imposing total.

For Panjab University, Rajesh Kumar was the pick of the bowlers, claiming two wickets for 38 runs, while Surya and Vijay Kumar Dogra chipped in with a wicket each. Chasing 235 for victory, Panjab University managed 161 runs for the loss of nine wickets in 20 overs. Naveen top-scored with 47 runs, while Anmy (25), Devinder Singh (23), and Vijay Kumar (19) contributed useful knocks.

Karan Sharma was exceptional with the ball for the University of Jammu, taking five wickets for just 31 runs.
