the Nitish Kumar government, retained his reserved seat of Kalyanpur where he trounced his nearest CPI(M) Liberation rival Ranjeet Kumar Ram by a margin of more than 38,000 votes. He has won the seat for a fourth consecutive time.

Sarangi, a Marwari who has made a mark for himself in Bihar's caste dominated politics, retained Darbhanga for a fifth consecutive time. The BJP leader, who was the minister for revenue and land reforms, defeated Umesh Sahni of Vikassheel Insaan Party (VIP) by a margin of over 24,500 votes.

voters who cast their votes in my favour and to the party leadership for the confidence they have shown in me," she told reporters here.

On the bypoll outcome, she said, "We are deeply grateful for the warm welcome we received, just as every household and family in Nagrota had blessed Rana Sahab in 2024. Today, people have extended their blessings to us with the same love and support. We dedicate this victory to Rana Sahab as a mark of respect. We wish to serve the people just as he did."

Meanwhile, Opposition PDP candidate Aga Syed Muntazir on Friday won the Budgam assembly bypoll in Jammu and Kashmir, defeating ruling National Conference (NC) candidate Aga Syed Mehmood by a margin of nearly 4,500 votes.

This is the first time that the NC has lost in its bastion of Budgam, in central Kashmir, since 1957, the first elections for the legislative assembly.

According to the data on the ECI website, Muntazir secured 21,576 votes against Mehmood's 17,098 at the end of the counting of votes. The B-JP candidate Aga Syed Mohsin stood a distant sixth with just 2,619 votes.

in the Election Commission, the prime minister said. He also hailed Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar's leadership and congratulated NDA allies for the electoral win.

"The people of Bihar, with this massive victory and their unshakable confidence, have taken the state by storm (garda uda diya)," he said.

In an apparent reference to the Muslim-Yadav support base of the Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD), Modi said in Bihar, some parties had formulated an "MY formula" but today's victory has given a new "positive MY -- Mahila and Youth" formula.

"Today, Bihar is among the states with a high youth population, and these youths belong to all religions and castes. Their wishes, aspirations and their dreams have destroyed the communal MY formula of the jungle raj people," Modi said in a swipe at the opposition.

He said the Bihar polls have also shown that the voters, especially the young ones, take the purification of the electoral list seriously.

The youth of Bihar have also extended tremendous support to the revision of electoral rolls, he said.

Modi also hailed the Election Commission for ensuring that elections take place smoothly and recalled how violence was the norm during the 'jungle raj', an apparent reference to RJD rule.

Victory of every...

CPI(M) also won one seat. Shah said that in the last 11 years, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has worked wholeheartedly for Bihar and Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has worked to pull the state out of the darkness of 'jungle raj'.

"A heartfelt salute to the people of 'Bihar Bhumi', the protectors of knowledge, hard work and democracy," he said.

NC will analyze...

"There is an English proverb - you cut your nose to spite your face. Whatever message he wanted to send to me is one thing, but politically he has taken a suicidal step," Abdullah said, adding "the person (PDP's Aga Syed Muntazir Mehdi) who won the seat from there will never allow him to rise again."

The chief minister said that while he could personally recover political losses, Ruhullah's future in the Budgam constituency was now fundamentally uncertain.

He also mentioned that the NC would not jump to conclusions about the defeat, attributing it partly to the unique voting demographics of the area.

After receiving the full payment and handing over possession of the said land, the accused refused to provide the revenue documents.

Accordingly, a probe was ordered at Police Station Economic Offences Wing (Crime Branch Kashmir), and investigation revealed that the accused persons, posing as land brokers, had sold land that did not belong to them, thereby cheating the complainants and misappropriating their money.

Subsequently, a formal case was registered, and after thorough investigation and corroboration of evidence, the chargesheet was filed before the competent court for judicial determination. The Crime Branch Kashmir has reiterated its commitment to act firmly against economic offenders and advises the public to exercise due caution while entering into land or property transactions, reads the statement.
