Katra chamber calls on Satish Sharma

KATRA: A delegation of the Chamber of Tourism Trade and Industry Katra (CTTIK) comprising president Raj Kumar Padha, secretary Atul Sharma and executive member Neelam Singh, today met S. Satish Sharma, Minister for Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Transport, Information Technology, Youth Services and Sports, in the presence of Vikas Gupta, director Tourism Jammu. The meeting took place on the sidelines of the flag-off ceremony of the Jambu Gedi Bus Service by Chief Minister Omar Abdullah at the Jammu Tawi Golf Course Sidhra.
During the interaction, the CTTIK delegation raised several pressing issues impacting the business and tourism sector of Katra. Key concerns included the hardships faced by local establishments that have recently received Section

7(3) notices from the Municipal Committee Katra and the Katra Development Authority. The delegation also discussed the urgent need to promote pilgrim tourism originating from Katra and strategically divert and extend tourist movement to other destinations such as Jammu, Shivkhori, Patnitop, Bhaderwah and the Kashmir Valley. Additionally, the need for prioritising critical infrastructure projects to enhance Katra's appeal and attract higher tourist footfall was strongly emphasised.
Responding to the delegation minister Satish Sharma informed them about the government's latest initiative to boost cruise tourism in Jammu & Kashmir. He shared that the J&K Government has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI).

SBI Card advises customers on smarter, safer digital transaction

JAMMU: With India witnessing an unprecedented shift toward digital payments, SBI Card has urged customers to exercise greater caution while transacting online, especially during the ongoing International Fraud Awareness Week. As UPI, credit cards, digital wallets, and e-commerce platforms continue to dominate spending patterns, the company emphasized that convenience must always be accompanied by vigilance. Digital transactions have surged sharply, with e-commerce accounting for 66.4% of total credit card spends in September 2025. Shopping for electronics, jewellery, travel, and other lifestyle essentials has moved largely online, creating opportunities for both seamless payments and potential cyber fraud. Speaking on the rising need for digital security, an SBI Card official said, "As digital payments become deeply integrated into everyday life, it is essential for customers to stay alert and adopt safe practices. Fraudsters are using increasingly sophisticated methods, and awareness is the strongest defence. Our aim is to empower cardholders with the right information so their shopping experience remains secure and enjoyable." Customers should shop only on trusted websites, avoiding random links or attachments shared via social media or messaging apps. The official stressed, "Unverified links remain one of the most common gateways for digital fraud." Users are advised to avoid screen sharing and not to download third-party apps or APK files that may compromise personal and financial information. Verifying deals and offers—especially unusually high discounts—was another major recommendation.
"Reward point seams are on the rise, and SBI Card cautioned customers against clicking on suspicious links or sharing card details to redeem points. Enabling real-time transaction alerts and staying alert to phishing emails or calls claiming account suspension or expiring offers were emphasised as crucial safeguards," the official said. The official added, "Genuine banks or card issuers will never ask for OTPs, PINs, passwords, or CVV. Customers must be extremely careful and report any suspicious communication immediately." SBI Card official also urged users to keep devices updated, use strong passwords, enable multi-factor authentication, and never share confidential information on social media platforms.
With fraud patterns evolving rapidly, SBI Card reiterated that awareness is key. "By staying informed and practising safe payment habits, customers can enjoy the full benefits of credit cards—security, rewards, and convenience—without compromising safety," the official concluded.
