SRINAGAR: The much-awaited Kashmir to Kanyakumari (K2K) Cycling Expedition was ceremoniously flagged off on Saturday from TRC Stadium, Srinagar, by Secretary, Jammu & Kashmir Sports Council, Nuzhat Gul.

The event marks the celebration of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's 150th birth anniversary, symbolizing the spirit of national integration and unity that the Iron Man of India envisioned.

A total of 150 cyclists from across India have embarked on this remarkable journey, including 20 women and one cyclist from Kashmir; Rafiq Ahmad. Speaking on the occasion, Nuzhat Gul said, "The K2K expedition is not just a test of endurance but a tribute to the spirit of unity and the diversity that makes India truly great. Starting this journey from the land of Kashmir the crown of India gives it even deeper meaning. It reflects the nation's strength, inclusivity, and collective resolve to stay united and fit."

Over the next 18 days, the cyclists will traverse 4,249 kilometres pedaling through diverse terrains, climates, and cultures as they move from the serene valleys of Kashmir to the southern tip of Kanyakumari.

It is for the information of all the migrants registered with the Relief Organization(M) J&K, that the Government of Jammu & Kashmir, in terms of S.O 392 and S.O. 393 of 2024, both dated 13th August, 2024, has made necessary amendments in the Jammu & Kashmir Food Security Rules, 2021 and the Targeted Public Distribution (Control) Order 2023, for integration of the ration cards of Kashmiri/Jammu Migrants into the National Food Security Act (NFSA) database, to enable them to avail the benefits of various Government Schemes.

In this connection special/daily camps are being organized at Zonal Offices/Camps by the Department of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs in collaboration with the Relief Organisation (M) J&K, for integration of migrant ration cards into the RCMS database. Those who have already submitted application for integration of ration card are requested to remain in touch with the concerned Zone/Camp and get details uploaded on the portal. The family members can get e-KYC done on "MeracKYC APP" for which there is no need for family members to visit the Zonal Office/Camp in person.

The migrants (both Relief and Non Relief category) registered with the Relief Organisation (M) J&K, who have still not submitted requisite information for integration of their Migrant Ration Cards into the National Food Security Act (NFSA) database are requested to share the same on the link: <http://www.rrem.jk.gov.in/services> (online) or in their respective Zone/Camp, immediately, without any further delay. TRAFFIC ADVISORY FOR JHIRI MELA 2025

Annual Jhiri Mela shall start w.e.f. 04.11.2025, where a large gathering is expected to witness the Mela from outside the UT of J&K and within the UT of J&K. In order to ensure smooth flow of traffic from Jammu to Jhiri and vice-versa, the general public is requested to follow the following traffic diversions/restrictions for smooth plying of vehicles, so that no inconvenience to general public is caused: -

RESTRICTIONS/DIVERSIONS: -

1. All the Inter-state buses/devotee vehicles coming from Punjab, Kathua, Samba, shall follow the route from Raya Morh – Ring Road – Sua No. 01 – Jhiri and back from same route.

2. The vehicles of devotees from Gandhi Nagar area, R.S Pura and adjoining areas shall take Ring Road from Miran Sahib for Jhiri and shall return back via same route.

3. All Buses/Mini buses/commercial vehicles plying from Bus Stand Jammu will adopt Bus Stand-Maheshpora Chowk-Bakshi Nagar Pulli to adopt Akhnoor Road and will take left turn from Sua No. 1 for Jhiri.

4. All private LMVs will take left turn from Mishriwala Chowk Jammu-Akhnoor Road to Jhiri.

5. All Medium Vehicles will take left turn from Simbliwalla & Chak Mani Jammu-Akhnoor Road to Jhiri.

6. All the heavy vehicles viz passenger buses, trucks & load carriers of other States on Jammu-Akhnoor road meant for Jhiri will adopt route from Sua No.1 - Chack Soodiana - Chak Kranti - Jhiri.

7. The entire internal local route PSVs/LMVs shall be diverted from the Cutoff point at Hari Singh Gharat.

8. No heavy vehicle shall be allowed to ply on the road from Mishriwala Chowk(NHW) to Jhiri .

9. All the vehicles of the devotees/participants shall remain parked in the designated parking slots around the Venue and approaching roads shall be kept free for vehicular movement.

10. No vehicle shall be allowed to be parked on either side of the road. Action under the provisions of M.V.Act/rule shall be taken against the violators by the officer Incharge.

11. All the motorists/vehicle operators shall follow the Traffic diversions made in connection with Jhiri Mela in the jurisdiction of Traffic City Jammu.

12. Public in general and devotees in particular are requested to co-operate with Traffic Police for their convenience during the Mela period and park their vehicles in parking slots not on road side.
