LG visits Poonch...

He expressed gratitude to the district administration, police, army, CAPFs, emergency responders, civil society members and volunteers for saving many lives during the natural calamities and unprovoked Pakistani shelling and extending support to the affected families. He also lauded the HRDS India's team for its noble initiative.

The Lieutenant Governor highlighted that the most pressing need for affected families is a safe roof over their heads.

"A total of 1,500 houses to be built in the first phase across the Union Territory and will be handed over to the beneficiaries within six-months of the beginning of the foundation work. These new three-bedroom prefabricated Smart Houses are designed to help families quickly get their lives back on track," he said. These houses will have specific facilities such as cowsheds. The maintenance for the next 5 years will be done by HRDS India. In the second phase, solar panels will also be installed in these houses. The houses being constructed at Poonch and Rajouri will cost around Rs.51 Crore, which will be borne by the HRDS India. The Lieutenant Governor directed the district administration for inclusion of the genuine beneficiaries. He said that there is no cap on the number of houses to be built.

"This project is specifically designed for those who are economically weak. Their welfare is the greatest service," the Lieutenant Governor said.

The Lieutenant Governor highlighted that under the leadership of the Prime Minister, the rapid, inclusive development witnessed across Jammu and Kashmir, including Poonch and Rajouri in the last few years is unprecedented in its pace and scale. "The people of Poonch and Rajouri faced neglect for decades and suffered from terrorism perpetrated by the neighbouring country. Today, a new ray of development has replaced that dark phase, and false promises. For the first time since independence, the people of these two districts are reaping the benefits of the development they have been entitled to. I assure that this process will continue unabated," the Lieutenant Governor said.

The Lieutenant Governor shared the key measures taken to improve the infrastructure in Poonch and Rajouri.

He observed that over the past few years, 1,125 bunkers have been completed in Poonch and a proposal to build 5,693 additional bunkers has been submitted for approval. In Rajouri, 2,923 bunkers were constructed in five years, providing relief to a large population living along the border; he added.

The Lieutenant Governor observed that 19 NoKs of terror affected families in Rajouri and 9 in Poonch were provided with government jobs. He also instructed the District and Police Administration to identify the left-out terror victim families and forward their job-appointment related cases to the Government Administration Department.

In Chhattisgarh, the BSF has forced 127 Maoists to surrender; arrested 73, and neutralised 22," Shah said.

The checking follows the earlier arrest of a doctor in the "white collar" module and the recovery of an AK rifle hidden in his locker at the Government Medical College, Anantnag.

According to the spokesperson, police teams, accompanied by officials of the health department, reminded the hospital staff during the searches

to use lockers strictly for official purposes and maintain proper records.

They also said such inspections would be part of the routine vigilance to maintain a safe environment in hospitals.

On Friday, the Srinagar police shifted its focus to the city's commercial sector as well, with thorough inspections of chemical and fertiliser shops across the city, the spokesperson said. The police team checked for proper maintenance of stock and sales records, identity verification procedures for bulk purchasers, secure storage of materials with potential security implications, besides ensuring the validity of licenses and adherence to regulatory norms.

The police teams also briefed the shop owners on the need for increased security measures, asking them to promptly report any suspicious transactions and maintain complete transparency, the official said.

A security check at car showrooms across the city was also conducted to discourage vehicle misuse in criminal activities and ensure that all car dealers comply with safety measures and documentation requirements.

The inspection mainly focused on checking maintenance of stock and sales records, identity verification for purchasers, compliance with security-related guidelines, and validity of licenses.

The dealers were counselled to "be always vigilant" and report any transaction considered suspicious, the spokesperson said.

IAF's Tejas fighter jet crashes during Dubai Air Show, pilot dies

DUBAI/NEW DELHI: A Tejas fighter jet of the Indian Air Force crashed in a ball of fire on Friday during an aerial display at the Dubai Air Show killing the lone pilot, in the second accident involving the indigenous multi-role Light Combat Aircraft in less than two years. The pilot was identified as Wg Cdr Namansh Syal, who is in his mid-30s and hails from Himachal Pradesh, according to available accounts. As the crash inside the grounds of an airfield in Dubai cast a tragic shadow on an otherwise mega spectacle on the last day of the event in the desert city, video footage of the accident showed the jet abruptly dropping height after what looked like a low-altitude manoeuvre and



then nosedived into the ground in a matter of seconds before being engulfed in a ball of fire. Black smoke billowed over the Al Maktoum International Airport at Dubai World Central, as horrified spectators, including women and children, assembled in large numbers at a grand

stand area behind a fenced airstrip watched in shock. The single-engine light weight aircraft crashed around 2:10 pm local time (3:40 pm IST) after the pilot had flown across the site of the prestigious air show in Dubai during the demonstration flight. The aerial display of Tejas was scheduled to last eight minutes.

"An IAF Tejas aircraft met with an accident during an aerial display at Dubai Air Show, today. The pilot sustained fatal injuries in the accident.

"IAF deeply regrets the loss of life and stands firmly with the bereaved family in this time of grief. A court of inquiry is being constituted, to ascertain the cause of the accident," the IAF said in a brief statement posted on its X handle.
