The event brought together participants of the ongoing Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) Training Programme, along with JKSCERT faculty and staff, to honour the ideals enshrined in the Constitution of India.

The DIKSHA Team introduced a new online course titled "Hamara Samvidhan @75: Understanding Our Rights, Duties & Equality," formally unveiled by Prof. (Dr.) Sindhu Kapoor, Joint Director, SCERT Jammu.

With this, Jammu & Kashmir has become the first Union Territory in India to launch a Constitution-based course on DIKSHA and also the first UT to introduce a course on the newly upgraded DIKSHA Learning Management System (LMS).
