MD HADP inspects dev activities at SM Farm Chinore

JAMMU: Mission Director Holistic Agriculture Development Program (HADP) - JKICP, Sandeep Kumar, on Sunday conducted an extensive tour of SM Farm Chinore to review ongoing developmental activities and assess the progress of interventions being implemented by the Department of Agriculture Production & Farmers' Welfare.

Sandeep Kumar was accompanied by Director Agriculture Jammu Anil Gupta; Joint Director Agriculture (SLUB/Farms) Dr. Aman Jyoti Sharma; Farm Manager Verinder Dogra and other officers and officials of the department.

During the visit, the Mission Director assessed the readiness of the farm for the upcoming Rabi season, with a focus on varieties of wheat crops. He emphasized that the seed multiplication process from breeder seed to foundation seed is a critical

aspect in ensuring consistent supply of high-quality seeds to farmers. Discussions were held with the Director Agriculture Jammu and farm staff to gather insights and address any challenges anticipated for the cultivation season.

He also took a detailed overview of the innovative agricultural practices and infrastructure development initiatives aimed at enhancing farm productivity and sustainability. The Mission Director interacted with field officers and farm staff, underscoring the importance

of adopting modern and sustainable technologies to improve the efficiency of departmental farms.

Earlier in the day, the Mission Director visited Lalihal village in Panchayat Kana Chak, where he interacted with progressive Krishi Udhamsi, Pinky Sharma (KKG Kanachak) and Bisham Khajuria (KKG Rajpura). The Mission Director discussed with them the challenges faced in the functioning of the Kisan Khidmat Ghars (KKGs) and assured that the department will further strengthen the

KKGs through enhanced support and integration with departmental activities.

It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned by the Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Rajouri that, despite repeated verbal and written directions, you have completely failed to rectify the damaged Bituminous Surface on the above-captioned road.

Geotagged photographs (attached herewith) clearly depict the non-existence of any activity or mobilization at site. The road surface has deteriorated badly, leading to serious hardship to the local population and loss of public faith in departmental works.

Repeated opportunities have been extended to you for taking up the work, but your consistent indifference and non-responsiveness show deliberate negligence and gross violation of contractual obligations.

Therefore, you are hereby finally directed as under:

- To mobilize adequate manpower, machinery, and material at site within 48 hours of issuance of this notice.
- To rectify the damaged renewal coat immediately and ensure that the work is completed within the stipulated time.
- To intimate this office and the concerned Executive Engineer with fresh progress photographs (geotagged) within the next 02 days.

Failure to comply with these directions shall result in the following:

- Initiate termination of contract as per the agreement conditions;
- Forfeit your performance security, earnest money, and any other deposits; and
- Recommend blacklisting of your firm for all future PMGSY works

Be informed that this notice shall be treated as FINAL and CONCLUSIVE.

- No further correspondence, plea, or representation shall be entertained thereafter.
- You will be solely responsible for all consequences arising out of your continued failure.
