Dr. Parneesh alleges discrimination in MBBS Admissions at SMVD Institute of Medical Excellence

■ STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: Senior BJP leader Dr. Parneesh Mahajan has raised serious concerns over alleged discrimination in the maiden MBBS admission list of the newly established Sri Mata Vaishno Devi Institute of Medical Excellence (SMVDIME), Katra. He questioned the transparency of the selection process carried out by the J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examinations (JK BOPEE) and expressed shock over the religious imbalance in the admitted batch at an institution fully funded by the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB) - a statutory Hindu religious body. Citing official figures, Dr. Mahajan said, "Out of the 50 students selected for the first MBBS batch, 42 belong to the Muslim community, while only eight are from the Hindu community. This disproportionate representation has naturally raised questions among devotees and the general public." He further stated that while the BJP believes in equality and merit-based opportunities,



this institution cannot be ignored," he asserted. Dr. Mahajan called for a transparent review of the admission process and urged the Chief Minister Omar Abdullah-led government and JK BOPEE to clarify the parameters used for seat allocation. He emphasized that the government must ensure justice and transparency in all academic institutions, especially those established in the name of revered religious bodies. He appealed to the administration to take corrective measures to restore public faith and prevent such controversies in the future. Police seeks public help in identification of body

Abducted girl recovered; accused arrested

■ STATE TIMES NEWS SRINAGAR: J&K Police have arrested a kidnapper and safely recovered the kidnapped girl (name withheld) from his possession after a swift and well-coordinated operation. Acting on specific input, on the directions of SSP Ganderbal Shri Khalil Ahmad Poswal-JKPS, a special police team from Police Post Shadipora traced out and apprehended the accused Firdous Rustum Khan son of Rustum Ali Khan resident of Shatigam, Handwara from the State of Himachal Pradesh. It is pertinent to mention that the accused is a vagabond and was already married around ten years ago, having two children. The investigation further revealed that the accused had been using social media and other online platforms to lure girls. After completing all medico-legal formalities, the recovered girl was handed over to her legal heirs. In this connection, a case FIR No. 185/2025, under relevant sections of law stands registered at Police Station Ganderbal, and further investigation is in progress.

52 Tons of Paper loaded from Kathua to Azara under Jammu Division's freight initiative

■ STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: In a significant development under the Northern Railway's Jammu Division, 52 tons of paper were successfully loaded from Kathua Railway Station to Azara Railway Station of the Rangiya Division, Guwahati, Assam, on November 5, 2025. The consignment, comprising 952 bundles and paper rolls, was transported in a BCN wagon at a freight rate of Rs 1.28 lakh, marking another milestone in the division's freight expansion efforts. Following the establishment of the Jammu Division, several initiatives have been launched under the Freight Policy by Divisional Railway Manager Vivek Kumar and Senior Divisional Commercial Manager Uchit Singhal to make freight movement more efficient, affordable, and accessible, particularly for small and

medium businesses. Uchit Singhal, Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, stated, "Under the freight policy, our division aims to enhance freight handling capacity, ensuring seamless movement of goods nationwide while strengthening railway infrastructure." He further added that this is the second such successful dispatch from Kathua, following a 46-ton consignment sent to Azara on July 23, 2025, which reflects the growing confidence of traders in rail-based logistics. The Jammu Division continues to encourage the local business community to adopt rail freight services, which not only help reduce logistics costs but also boost regional trade and generate employment opportunities, contributing significantly to economic growth and railway revenue.

JMC Com inspects civic amenities in Govt Quarters

■ STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: Commissioner Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) Dr. Devansh Yadav on Thursday visited different areas of Jammu City and inspected the status of civic amenities at residential Quarters earmarked for Civil Secretariat Darbar Move employees. During the visit, Dr. Yadav took stock of the overall sanitation system and interacted with residents to understand their concerns regarding cleanliness, waste disposal and mosquito control in the locality. He directed the concerned officers to ensure that both dry and wet waste from every household and surrounding areas be properly segregated at the source. He emphasized that all collected waste must be loaded systematically into autos for transportation and scientific disposal at the designated waste management sites to maintain hygiene and prevent littering. Highlighting the importance of preventive health measures, Dr. Yadav instructed the concerned sanitation and health teams to intensify spraying and fogging operations in and around the residential quarters to prevent mosquito breeding and control the spread of vector-borne diseases such as dengue and chikungunya. He also stressed on the need to identify stagnant water sources, clean drains and maintain proper waste disposal channels to eliminate potential breeding grounds. The Commissioner reiterated JMC's commitment to maintaining a clean, healthy and disease-free environment for all citizens and directed officers to ensure that every sanitation worker and supervisory staff performs their duties diligently. He also



appealed to the residents to cooperate with the Corporation's teams by keeping their surroundings clean, segregating waste at home and reporting any sanitation-related issues through the JMC helpline or mobile application. Reviewing the existing cleanliness arrangements, the Commissioner issued on-the-spot directions to the field staff to maintain strict vigilance and ensure daily lifting of garbage from residential quarters and open spaces. He further directed that door-to-door waste collection be monitored regularly and public awareness on waste segregation be increased among residents and workers alike.
