

CRIME REPORT**Woman killed, 13 injured in bus accident at Kathua****STATE TIMES NEWS**

KATHUA: A 32-year-old woman was killed and 13 others were injured when a bus turned turtle in Kathua district on Sunday, officials said. The accident took place at Galak village on Dayala Chak road when driver lost control over the vehicle (JK14C-9586) at a sharp curve, they said, adding that



bus was going towards Jammu. Soon after the mishap, rescuers rushed to site and 14 injured persons were shifted to Ramkote Community Health Centre. A woman, identified as Sushma Devi, succumbed to injuries during treatment, the officials said. Six injured persons, identified as Meenakshi, Priya and Shivanji of Galak, Pooja of Dramni, Susheela Jasrotia of Hiranagar and Puja Devi of Dadwara were further referred to the Government Medical College and Hospital, Kathua for specialised treatment, they said, adding that all other injured were discharged after first-aid.

Bootlegger nabbed with 52 bottles of illicit liquor**STATE TIMES NEWS**

SAMBA: Intensifying its drive against sale of illicit liquor, District Police Samba arrested a bootlegger and recovered 52 bottles (180 ml each) of illicit liquor.

As per details, a party from Police Station Samba led by SHO Samba, Inspector Deepak Jasrotia during vehicle-checking Naka at SIDCO Chowk Samba, intercepted a motorcycle (PB10CB/1595) coming from Samba and moving towards Mansar. On checking, a total of 52 bottles of JK Special Desi Whisky (180 ml each) were recovered from his possession. The accused, identified as Raman Kumar, son of Khajoor Chand, resident of Tant (Nud), Tehsil & District Samba, was arrested and FIR No. 06/2022 under section 48 (A) of Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Samba.

**Bovine smuggling bid foiled; 14 animals rescued****STATE TIMES NEWS**

NOWSHERA: Police on Sunday foiled a bovine smuggling bid by rescuing 14 bovines from two vehicles.

As per details, in wee hours of Sunday morning, Police Station Dharamsala received information that two vehicles are moving in suspicious conditions towards Solki Naka, after which a team headed by SHO Neeraj Choudhary strengthened Naka to

intercept both vehicles. However sensing police alertness, drivers of both vehicles abandoned their vehicles at some distance before Naka and escaped in roadside forests. Both vehicles (JK11D 3052 & JK11E 7670) were found parked on road, which were seized and fourteen bovine animals, tied mercilessly in vehicles, were rescued. Cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at Police Station Dharamsala with further investigation is going on.

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police recovered 15 gm heroin from a drug peddler.

As per details, during Naka checking near KC Crossing below flyover at BC road Jammu, a team from Police Station Bus-Stand led by SHO Inspr Deepankar Singh under supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu, intercepted a person who turned suspicious on seeing police Naka & tried to flee but was timely overpowered by police. On search, 15 gm heroin was recovered from his possession. The accused, identified as Jaleel Ahmed, son of Mohd Bashir, resident of Dhera Babber Tehsil Reasi District Reasi, was arrested and FIR under relevant sections of law was registered.
