JAMMU: Under National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR), Jammu & Kashmir State Level Coordinating Agency (JKSLCA) in collaboration with National Institute of Social Defense (NISD), MOSJE, GoI on Friday organized a one-day awareness programme on "Drug Abuse and Preventive Measures" for community members at JKSPYM Seminar Hall.

By strictly following the COVID-19 protocol, around 30 members participated in the programme.

Resource persons, Pooja Kumari and Shikha from NGO delivered a lecture on "Drug

Abuse and Preventive Measures".

As per National Action Plan on Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MOSJE), GoI, programmes like these need to be conducted on a regular basis covering all strata of society.

Resource person talked about the motive of the programme which is to generate awareness regarding the drug abuse, preventive measures and treatment.

She explained that drug/ alcohol abuse is raising day by day in the society and youth of our society is involving at large number in the addiction.

She discussed various types of

drugs (tobacco, caffeine, depressants, stimulants etc.) and how they are consumed.

Shikha educated the participants about the long- and short-term effects of different types of drugs on body, mind, career and family.

She further added that drug addiction is not only confined to body, mind and career but it is also illegal to consume it.

She generated awareness among members about various services provided by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment for Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment i.e., Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA), Outreach and Drop-in Centre (ODIC) and Community Peer Led Intervention (CPLI).

Pamphlets were distributed among the participants.

Programme ended with discussions and Question-answer session and resource persons patiently answered all the queries of the participants. At the end, Komal Sharma, SLCA official concluded the programme with vote of thanks.

NEW DELHI: On the occasion of 147th Foundation Day of India Meteorological Department on Friday, Union Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh inaugurated and dedicated to the nation four Doppler Weather Radars at Leh, Mumbai, Delhi and Chennai respectively for better operational analysis and more accurate forecasts.

With today's inauguration, the number of such radars in the country has reached up to 33. The Minister said that augmentation of modern observing platforms such as Automatic weather stations, Doppler Weather Radars and Meteorological Satellites will help in further improving weather and climate services.

Dr Jitendra Singh said that India has taken a lead in Asian Continent to provide Weather and Climate services to South Asian, South-East Asian and Middle East countries.

Addressing a galaxy of administrators, scientists and scholars on the occasion, Dr Jitendra said that the severe

weather forecasting being provided to many countries since 2016 under PM Narendra Modi has come a long way and proved handy to countries like Nepal and Bangladesh in fighting severe climatic disasters. Referring to ISRO's SAARC Satellite, the Minister said, in coming days, IMD will reorient its weather and cli-

mate services in the most modern way to cater to global needs.

Dr Jitendra said that the Ministry of Earth Sciences will deploy and use Drone based Observation Technology in a big way for strengthening the localised forecasting, besides adopting the High Resolution Models.

He emphasised that the language used in forecast and information would be made easy to understand and serve as a clear basis for taking action by every citizen.

In continuation to earlier advertisement notice issued under endorsement No. Pers-Rectt-A-22-2019/16251-300 dated 09-03-2019 for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions (one Battalion each in Jammu/Kashmir Region) and in pursuance to Government of Jammu and Kashmir Home Department letter No. Home-PNG/201/2021-01-(CC-45001) dated 17-12-2021, wherein the competent authority has approved for issuance of fresh advertisement notification excluding UT of Ladakh so as to give opportunity to eligible candidates who are domicile of Jammu and Kashmir to apply and participate in the selection process and be considered as per existing rules.

Police Recruitment Board invites online applications from eligible (Female candidates only), Domicile of UT J&K for participation in the selection process for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions of the Jammu and Kashmir Police, as per guidelines conveyed by MHA GOI vide letter No. 13030/50/2015.K.II (pt) dated 13-06-2018, wherein 60% posts will be kept reserved for women of border districts of Jammu region and will be equally divided among border districts. Remaining 40% of posts will be equally distributed for rest of the districts of Jammu region. Similarly, in Kashmir region 60% of posts shall be kept reserved for women of Border districts and will be equally divided among border districts of Kashmir. Remaining 40% of posts will be equally distributed in rest of the districts of Kashmir region in the Pay Band-I of Rs.5200-20200 + Grade pay 1900/- (Now revised 19900-63200 Level-2).

The candidates who had earlier qualified PET/PST for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions in response to PHQ Advertisement Notice issued under endorsement No. Pers-Rectt-A-22-2019/16251-300 dated 09-03-2019 need not apply again as they are eligible for the written examination.

Similarly the candidates who were disqualified in PET/PST under the above quoted advertisement can not apply again as their applications would not be considered.

2)- Reservation:

Reservation for Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes(ST), Economically Weaker Section(EWS), Pahari Speaking People(PSP), Social Caste (OSC), Residents Backward Area (RBA), Line of Actual Control(ALC)/International Border(IB) for the above posts, wherever applicable and admissible, would be as determined, in accordance with the provisions of SRO 294 dated 21-10-2005 and S.O 127 dated 20-04-2020.

A candidate seeking her consideration under Reserved Categories must ensure that she possess a valid/ Category Certificate as on the Cut-off Date of filling of application form, the certificate will have to be produced in accordance with timeline setup by the Board.

The candidates who had earlier qualified PET/PST under above quoted advertisement and possess any category certificate in pursuance to S.O 127 of 2020 dated 20-04-2020 can submit their requisite certificate issued by the competent authority to be considered against such reserved category.

3)- Domicile: -

The candidate should be a Domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir as defined in terms of the Notifications issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide S.O 1229 (E) dated 31-03-2020 and S.O 1245(E) dated 03-04-2020 read with notification issued by the General Administration Department. Government of Jammu and Kashmir vide S.O 166 dated 18-05-2020.

The candidate must possess Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority on the format prescribed for the purpose, before the last date of submission of online application form.

4)- I The educational qualification, age and physical standards prescribed for the abovementioned posts are specified as under:-

i)	Educational Qualification	The Candidate should have passed matriculation examination from any Government recognized Board by or before the last date for submission of application form.
ii)	Age (as on January, 1st, 2022)	a. The candidates should not be below 18 years and above 28 years in age. (The candidates born before 01.01.1994 and after 31.12.2003 shall not be eligible.) b. The candidates who were below 28 years of age at the time of issuance of earlier advertisement notification but could not apply being non permanent residents and have now acquired eligibility in view of being domicile of UT J&K and have crossed upper age limit shall also be eligible. c. However, in case of serving SPOs with a continuous period of engagement of minimum three years and Voluntary Home Guards (VHG) with a period of engagement of minimum five years, the upper age limit shall be 37 years and for Ex-Servicemen it shall be 48 years. d. The SPOs/VHG and Ex-servicemen who were below 37 years and 48 years of age at the time of issuance of earlier advertisement notification but could not apply being non permanent residents and have now acquired eligibility in view of being domicile of LT J&K and have crossed upper age limit shall also be eligible.
iii)	Physical Standards	Height = 5 feet -2 inch (minimum.) For candidates belonging to Gorkha community (Domicile of UT J&K) Height 5 feet (minimum.)

C.	Physical Standard Test(PST)	●Measurement of Height The candidates are also required to bring alongwith their original documents/testimonials for scrutiny during the PST.
D.	Written Examination (Objective type) Only for the candidates who qualify PET/PST shall be allowed to sit in written test.	The written test will consist of objective questions. The question paper will consist of 100 questions to be attempted in 2 hours. The question paper will be of matriculation standard will comprise questions on general awareness/general knowledge, elementary mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability.

5)- Since the 60% posts are to be equally distributed in Border Districts and 40% posts are to be equally distributed in remaining Districts, candidates belonging to the domicile District cannot apply for appointment in other District except SC category, who can apply only in any one District of her own choice of the UT of J&K. In case a candidate applies for appointment in more than one District, her application will be summarily rejected without any notice to the candidate.

6)- The instruction for filling up of online application form is enclosed as annexure "A". Candidate shall deposit a fee of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three hundred only) online or use the services of Common Service Centers. In case of non availability of online payment facility, the candidates may use the option of depositing the application fee through Bank Challan. Candidates are requested to read and follow these instructions carefully as no amount once deposited will ever be refunded for reasons whatsoever.

7)- Candidates already in Government service and conforming to the prescribed standards can apply through proper channel after obtaining NOC from their Head of the Department without which the online applications will not be entertained.

8)- The recruitment will be undertaken under Transparent Recruitment Process (TRP) through an Outsourcing firm.

9)- Last date for submission of online application form shall be 30 days after the activation of the link which will be notified separately. The last date for the receipt of the application provided in the notification shall be the cutoff date for determining the eligibility with regard to educational qualification/relevant category. Any qualification or claim accruing to the candidate after last date of receipt of application shall not be entertained. The selection of the candidates for the post of Constable shall be made at District level on their performance in written test vis-a-vis number of vacancies. In case of tie in merit, the preference will be given to the candidate older in age. In terms of S.O 290 of 2021 dated 20-08-2021 the candidates possessing National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificates shall be awarded bonus marks as per the said SO. However, those candidates who had qualified PET/PST possesses NCC certificate can submit valid NCC certificate issued before cut-off date of earlier advertisement notification.

10)- Since, the recruitment is being made for raising 02 Women Battalions on the strength of J&K Police, as such, the appointees will have to render their services wherever required in the UT of J&K.

11)- In terms of the directions issued by the State Government vide No. Home/PB-TI/62/G/2008 dated 25-09-2009, the horizontal reservation to the extent of 15% and 4% shall be given to eligible serving SPOs and VHGs respectively (provided SPOs have completed continuous engagement of 03 years and VHGs have completed 05 years of service on the last date of submission of online application). Besides, horizontal reservation to the extent of 6% shall be given to eligible Ex-Servicemen.

12)- The candidate working as SPOs/Volunteer Home Guard and conforming to the eligibility as envisaged in para 4-I(ii) of the notice shall attach certificate(s) relating to their engagement as SPO/Volunteer Home Guards issued by the concerned DDO/SSP under his seal/signatures with date of issue. No such certificate will be entertained after the last date of submission of online application.

13)- The fixation of pay of the appointees shall be regulated as per the provisions of SO 192 of 2020 dated 17-06-2020.

14)- Upon their appointment, candidates who have obtained any loan/stipend under the self employment scheme or any other category will be allowed to join only in case they obtain a clearance certificate from the concerned department/bank to the effect they have refunded the loan/cleared the liability.

15)- The candidates shall have to appear in the prescribed tests at their own expenses on the date and venue to be communicated by the Police Recruitment Board, through press or electronic media.

16)- In case, it is found at any stage of recruitment that the candidate was not eligible for the post or has given wrong information, her candidature shall be summarily rejected without any further notice to her and the same may attract legal action.

17)- The selected candidates shall be subjected to prescribed medical examination /checkup through Standing Medical Boards and the appointment orders shall be issued only after receipt of satisfactory medical report and clearance about her character/antecedents from CID. The elected candidates shall be required to undergo the prescribed Basic Training Course.

Whereas, the provisional select list was issued vide Notification No.93-PSC(DR-S) of 2021, dated 07.12.2021 wherein 08 candidates were selected provisionally under different categories, with the stipulation that objections, if any, be submitted to the Commission within five days from the issuance of the provisional select list for examination/disposal and that no claim, whatsoever, shall be entertained after five days from the date of issuance of Notification; and	
In response to the above Notification, 04 representations have been received in the Commission as per the details below and are accordingly disposed off with the clarification/remarks indicated against each:-

01	Dr. Tanveer Hassan Bhat	The candidate has submitted the following grievance:- 1. That he was interviewed for about 40 minutes and the interview board asked to him to deliver a lecture on Water Resources for under graduate level, he not only answered almost all the questions of the interviewing panel/experts correctly but delivered the lecture to full satisfaction of the panel, but to his utter shock and surprise he has been awarded mere 13.75 points in the viva-voce plus Demo part. 2. The candidate has stated that he has been awarded 02 points for teaching experience while as he was getting 2.50 points and in the previous shortlisting notice dated 04.08.2021 his score was shown as 32.99. 3. The candidate has requested for rechecking of his score sheet and performance in the interview/demonstration.	1. The assessment of viva + Demo is the exclusive domain of the Experts on the interview board. 2. As per the check sheet, 02.00 points have been awarded to the candidate against experience. The checksheet has been duly signed by the Candidate at the time of interview. Therefore, the representation merits no consideration.
2.	Abdul Barey Shah	The candidate has submitted: i. that he has not been allotted any points in the Publications parameters of Water Management, the candidate has stated that he also appeared in the interview for the post of AP-EVS and he has been allotted 1.5 points for the same publications. ii. He has not been allotted any points for Conferences Presentations, when he has requested for rechecking his conference certificates again and allot him the points that he deserve.	The candidate had submitted 02 Non UGC Publications and 6 National Paper presentations before the Interview Board, which have not been accepted by the experts. The assessment of Special Attributes viz. Publications, Paper presentations etc. is the exclusive domain of experts on the Interview Board. Therefore, the representation merits no consideration.
3.	Javid Ahmad Dar	The candidate has stated that he appeared in the interview for the post of AP-Water Management but his result was kept withheld. In this regard he would like to know the reason for withholding his result.	The candidate was not found to be eligible for the post as he lacked the prescribed qualification. He was allowed to appear in the interview provisionally. His result has been kept withheld for want of clarification from the Administrative Department. Further, no document was available with the application form which would indicate the date of registration/date of result of PhD. MSP certificate was also not available to confirm that the P.hd has been done on regular basis which is a requirement as per UGC guidelines. Therefore, the representation merits no consideration.
4.	Dr. Syed Javid Ahmad Andrabi.	The candidate has stated that the select list for the post of AP-Water Management was published and he was figuring at serial No.01. In the select list there has been visible discrepancy in his name which instead of his actual name Dr. Syed Javid Ahmad Andrabi S/O. Syed Ahmadullah Andrabi has been shown as Dr. Syed Javid Ahmad S/O. Syed Ahmadullah, thereby omitting his last name "Andrabi". In view of the above, the candidate has requested to kindly rectify his name that has been incorrect shown in the selection list.	Representation considered.
