

Army reaches out to deaf & dumb villagers of Doda, distributes hearing-aids among them

Republic Day: Security tightened in Samba, border areas

BHADARWAH: Extending its community welfare development projects to extend helping hand to the tribal villagers suffering with mysterious illness (born deaf and dumb) that has struck like a curse in a particular village Dadhkai of Gandoh in Doda district, leaving 78 of

them deaf and dumb, Rashtriya Rifles unit based at Bhadarwah reached out to distribute specialized hearing aids among the differently abled children, beside starting tutorials to teach them sign language. Giving a new dimension to the Sadhbhavana project, Army

located the far off hill top village Dadhkai, 105 km from Bhadarwah town and came with a novel initiative to provide the deaf and dumb villagers with specialised hearing aids beside the RR unit also started 2 months door to door tutorials to teach the differently abled children the sign language.

The programme was inaugurated at Dadhkai-A village by SSP Doda Abdul Qayoom who was also the chief guest, while CO 4RR presided the function and Mohd Hanief/Deedar BDC Chairman was the guest of honour. Commanding Officer while addressing the villagers informed that the hearing equipment costing Rs 17,000 each have been especially designed for the deaf and dumb with life time warranty and will help the specially abled younger generation to understand the sign language for which experts will provide door to door tuition to affected Children. It is notable to mention here that out of total 105 families of Dadhkai-A village, 55 families are affected with the mysterious disorder having 78 born

deaf and dumb including 41 females. Appreciating the unique approach of Army, SSP Abdul Qayoom said that this gesture will not only provide the much needed self confidence among these villagers and will also help bring them out of the despair but outside world may also come to know about this mysterious disorder which is limited to this particular village. Chairman BDC Mohd Hanief appealed that Ministry Of Tribal Affairs should open a permanent special school for the deaf and dumb villagers which will be of great help to them. SSP, CO 4RR and SDM Gandoh assured that they will take up the matter with the concerned ministry with a request to open the School for differently abled tribal children.

- Candidates are advised to go through the instructions and all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the post before filling up the online Application Form.
- Last date for filling up of online Application complete in all respects along with the requisite fee (online mode only) is 19.02.2022.
- The last date for receipt of online applications provided in the notification shall be the cut-off date for determining the eligibility including acquisition of requisite educational and professional qualifications.
- The minimum and maximum age will however be reckoned with reference to 1st January, 2022.
- Candidates can fill some of the fields in their online application form w.e.f. 19.02.2022 to 21.02.2022 (up to 11:59 PM). Instructions in this regard will be separately made available on the website.
- Candidates are required to upload all the mandatory prescribed/requisite documents alongwith the online application form.
- In case the mandatory prescribed/requisite documents are not uploaded with the online application form, the application form/candidate of the applicant is liable to be rejected without any further notice.
- Candidates will not be required to submit a hard copy of the online application form or any other documents to the Commission at the time of filling up online application form.
- The candidate will however be required to present/produce a photocopy of the online application form alongwith the original certificate at the time of interview.
- Candidates are advised in their own interest to submit online applications much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/ability to pay fee or failure to login to the online application portal on account of heavy load on the website during the last date.

5. Reservation

- A candidate seeking his/her consideration under any Reserved Category must ensure that he/she possesses a valid requisite Category certificate as on the cut-off date.
- The category certificate should remain valid during and upto the completion of selection process.
- The candidature of the candidates will be provisional till the genuineness of the reserved category certificate is verified by the Appointing Authority.
- Candidates may note that in case a claim for reservation is made on the basis of false/fake/fraudulent certificate, he/she shall be debarred from the examination(s) conducted by the J&K Public Service Commission, in addition to any other penal action as may be deemed appropriate.

6. Domicile

The candidate should be a Domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir. The candidate must possess a valid Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribed format as on the last date prescribed for submission of online application form.

7. Requisite Fee

After successful submission of the online application form, candidate will be required to deposit requisite fee through online mode. The amount of fee to be paid is given below:

Note:

- The application Form submitted without deposition of the fee, which gets substantiated through reflection of the same on the application form, such application form shall be treated as incomplete and candidature shall be deemed to have been rejected without any notice. No representation against such rejection shall be entertained.
- Submission of multiple applications by way of prefixing Mr./Ms. or through generation of multiple User ID's or any other mode, followed by either non-payment of fee particulars or fee particulars (TID) of one application (RID) being mentioned against another application with a different RID would lead to rejection of the online application. The applicants who are submitting multiple applications should note that only the applications with higher Registration ID (RID) number shall be entertained by the Commission and fee paid against one RID shall not be adjusted against any other RID number. Besides a strict disciplinary action shall be taken including the cancellation of candidature and debarment for future examinations of J&K PSC will be taken against such applicants.

- Two years experience certificate from the teaching institutions recognized by the Medical Council of India (now National Medical Commission), as per format - 01 leaf

b) Documents (Mandatory) if claiming benefit under that category:-

- For Physically Challenged Candidates Disability certificate on the prescribed format, if required - 01 leaf.
- In-Service Certificate Signed by HOD.

- List of Conferences (Participation & Presentation) as per format - 01 leaf.
- List of Books as per format- 01 leaf.

It may be noted that no further opportunity to upload any document shall be provided hereafter and action under rules including rejection of application form/candidate etc will be taken.

9. Scheme of Selection

Selection shall be made in accordance with the provisions laid down in the Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission's (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021 as amended from time to time.

Candidates are especially advised to acquaint themselves with the provisions of Rule 44(G) of the Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission's (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021.

10. Important instructions regarding filling up of online applications are given herein below:-

- Candidates are required to apply online through the website of the Commission i.e. <http://www.jkpsc.jk.nic.in>. No other means/ mode of application shall be accepted.
- Candidates are first required to go to the JKPS website <http://www.jkpsc.jk.nic.in> and click on the link "One Time Registration" or click on Login menu if you have already created your profile with the JK PSC.
- After logging into your account, candidates are required to fill all the requisite fields of One Time Registration (OTR) i.e. personal information, contact information & educational qualification, service details etc.
- The candidate shall also be required to upload the image of date stamped recent passport size color photograph and signature. The photograph should not be taken earlier than 01.01.2021.
- Size of the photograph (passport size) and signatures must be between 10KB to 20KB in *.jpg or *.png only.
- After successful submission of all the details in your OTR account, check the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the advertisement notification before applying for the post.
- Click on the "show examination" as shown against the respective post/examination you want to apply.
- On Clicking on the "show examination" a window will appear on your computer screen. Select the month of the advertisement notification for which you want to apply, a link(s) for the post(s) will appear on the computer screen.
- An "APPLY" button is shown against the respective post and the candidate will click on the APPLY button against the post he/she is eligible.
- On clicking "APPLY" button, an instruction window will appear. Candidates should read instructions carefully before clicking on "APPLY" button at the bottom of the webpage.
- On clicking "APPLY" button, the system will display all facts/particulars that a candidate may have necessary while filling up the necessary fields of his/her OTR account. Candidate shall fill up the remaining required fields in the application form and accept the declaration thereof.
- Once the candidate is satisfied about the correctness of the filled in details, then, he or she may click on "SUBMIT" button to finally push the data into server with successful submission report.
- On successful submission of the basic details, the candidates will be required to pay the online fee and uploading of the documents, for final submission of the online application form.
- Candidates can pay the requisite fee through online mode in the "SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS" menu in your account.
- After successful payment of the fee, the fee status will get reflected on the Online Application form. Candidates can check the fee status by clicking on the **Final Application Status** in the submitted Applications menu in your JKPS account. In case the payment status shows either "not submitted or under processing or status has not been reflected on your submitted application form", candidates(s) are advised to contact the JKPS office at Solima Srinagar/Resham Ghar Colony Jammu immediately for clarification. Further where the online fee is paid through other service providers the candidate must ensure that not only the amount of fee is debited from his/her service provider's Account but also credited into the official account of JKPS.
- The candidate would be able get the printout of his/her submitted application only after the payment of the requisite fee and uploading of mandatory prescribed/requisite documents.
- The JKPS will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for the eligibility and other aspects at the time of filling up of online and therefore, candidature will be accepted only provisionally. The candidates are advised to go through the requirements of educational qualification, age, etc and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post(s). Copies of supporting documents will be sought at the time of document verification. When scrutiny is under taken, if any claim is made in the application is not found/substantiated by proof, the candidature will be cancelled and the Commission's decision shall be final and binding.
- Please note that the above procedure is the only valid procedure for applying. No other mode of application or incomplete steps would be accepted and such applications would be rejected.

11. Editing of the online application form

Candidates who have successfully submitted the online application form along with requisite fee will be allowed to edit some of the fields in their submitted online application form within three days after the cut-off date i.e. from 19.02.2022 to 21.02.2022 (upto 11:59 PM). Detailed instruction in this regard will be made available on the website.

12. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct

Candidates are advised that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information.

A candidate who is, or has been, declared by the Commission, to be guilty of:-

- obtaining by wrongful support of his/her candidature by any means, or
- impersonating, or
- procuring impersonation by any person, or
- submitting falsified documents or documents which have been tampered with or
- making statements which are incorrect, or false or suppressing material information, or
- resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the selection, or
- attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the Commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses (i) to (v), in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution,

shall be liable:-

- to be disqualified by the Commission from selection for which he/she is a candidate, and/or
- to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period:-
 - By the Commission from any selection held by them.
 - By the Union Territory Government from any employment under them and
- if he/she is already in service under Government, disciplinary action can be taken against him/her under the appropriate rules.
