JAMMU: The recently launched Digital Feedback System for the 27 G2C services has garnered an exceptional response from the public. The citizens in large numbers are rating various government services being provided by different departments and sharing their experience for further improving the service delivery mechanism.

An analysis of the received feedback reveals that services like Domicile Certificate of Revenue Department, Age Certificate of Health Department, IGNOAPS of Social Welfare, and Physically Challenged Certificate of Health Department are getting very good responses on the feedback mechanism (RAS).

It is expected that around 130 more services developed under EoDB (Ease of doing Business) will be included shortly. RAS is a

user-friendly Digital Feedback Mechanism that enables the citizens to provide effective feedback on the services offered to them through SMS and weblink thereby enhancing transparency and accountability. The Government departments have a graphical user interface (GUI) for assessing the feedback from citizens so as to further improve their service delivery.

Commissioner/ Secretary IT Department, Prerna Puri reviewed the progress of the digital feedback mechanism and reiterated that the UT administration is responsive to the needs of the public and the Rapid Assessment System is assisting the quality evaluation of G2C services being provided to the citizens. ATV rally, Ski-show held at Doodpathri

BUDGAM: In a bid to promote Doodpathri as a winter tourism destination, the Director Tourism G N Itoo and Deputy Commissioner Budgam, Shahbaz Ahmed Mirza on Wednesday inaugurated a first of its kind of 'All Terrain Vehicle' (ATV) rally from TRC up to Parhaiz Maidaan at Doodpathri in Budgam. On the occasion, a Snow Ski show was also held in which well trained skiers demonstrated their skills.

Speaking on the occasion, Director Tourism said that Doodpathri is being given special focus to be developed as best Winter Tourism spot, where activities like snow ski, snow- boarding, snow cycling, ATV's facility and other snow related activities shall be held every winter. He said that holding such activities shall not only promote the tourist footfall, but

also these facilities will create employment resources for the locals. The Director said that promotion of this destination would also facilitate hand holding of local youth who can participate and under capacity building earn their livelihood.

Emphasizing on the promotion of Doodpathri, the Director said that it has huge potential to be developed as good as Gulmarg and Pahalgam. "Today's event will be game changer for this destination as up to now tourists here used to get only pony ride, but from now onwards there are other activities they can participate and enjoy," said Director.

He said that a full-fledged snow sports equipments facility shall remain available for the tourists. He called for holding basic ski courses for students, tourists and other locals to promote footfall to Doodpathri

during winter months.

Speaking on the occasion, Deputy Commissioner (DC) Budgam said that the Budgam has huge potential for tourism and Doodpathri, Yousmarg and Tosamaidan destinations can be developed as best winter tourism spots. He said the need is to tap the tourism potential with providing all basic facilities to the tourists. The DC said that this is for the first time that road was made through up to Doodpathri during winter season. He said that District administration shall provide all support to the Tourism department in developing and promoting tourism at Doodpathri and other tourism spots in Budgam.

The DC said that a comprehensive tourism plan shall be devised and implemented under which all facilities shall be provided to the tourists for promotion of Doodpathri.

Therefore, keeping in view of Principal of Natural Justice, you are given final opportunity to start the said work immediately within 5 days, failing of which the proceedings warranted under rules shall be initiated against you without further notice and your CDR No. 112327 dated: 10-11-2021, J&K Bank Grameen Rajbagh amounting Rs. 11,840 shall be forfeited without further notice and you shall be blacklisted for next 3 years.
