

**Two SHOs among four Inspectors transferred****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Senior Superintendent of Police Samba on Saturday transferred two Station House Officers (SHOs) among four Inspectors.

As per order, Inspector Ali Imran has been transferred from Police Station Purmandal and posted as SHO Vijaypur; Inspector Tribhavan Khajuria has been transferred from Anti Gunda/Anti Narcotic Squad Samba and posted as SHO Purmandal; Inspector Bharat Sharma has been transferred from DPL Samba and posted as Incharge DSB Samba; Inspector has been transferred from DSB Samba and posted at Anti Gunda/Anti Narcotic Squad Samba.

**CRIME REPORT****Hit & run case solved; accused arrested****STATE TIMES NEWS**

KULGAM: Police on Saturday solved a hit & run case by arresting an accused.

As per details, Police Station Kulgam received information that a motorcycle driven by one Jahangir Ahmad Dar, son of Mohammad Subhan Dar, resident of Shurat Kulgam was hit by an unknown vehicle near village Laroo area of Kulgam, resulting into his on-spot death. The driver of the unknown vehicle fled away from spot along with vehicle. Accordingly, FIR number 258/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Kulgam and investigation was initiated. Accordingly a special investigation team was constituted to probe the hit and run case. Investigation team taking advantage of modern gadgets, technical evidences & human inputs were able to identify accused driver & subsequently arrested him within two days of incident. He was identified as Mashooq Ahmad Dar, son of Abdul Salam Dar, resident of DH Pora and his swift car bearing registration number DL5CK-9240 has also been seized. He has been shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Further investigation is in progress.

**Illegal extraction & transportation of minerals; 5 arrested, 5 vehicles seized****STATE TIMES NEWS**

BUDGAM: Police in Budgam has arrested 5 persons and seized 5 vehicles for illegal extraction and transportation of minerals. Acting on reliable information, officers from Police Station Beerwah at a checkpoint established at Mulshahera crossing intercepted 5 vehicles (Tippers) bearing registration numbers JK05B-3354, JK14B-8115, JK04C-3941, JK01T-3181 and JK03A-1808 involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals from Government land. All vehicles were seized on the spot and 5 persons have also been arrested, who were identified as Bashir Ahmad Malik, son of Ghulam Mohd Malik, resident of Dadina Budgam; Firdous Ahmad Gabor, son of Bashir Ahmad, resident of Budgam; Danish Ahmad Baba, son of Showkat Ahmad, resident of Qadipora Budgam; Ashiq Hussain Yatoo, son of Mohd Akbar, resident of Sholipora and Mohammad Yusuf Mir, son of Ghulam Mohi-ud-Din, resident of Waterwani Budgam. They were shifted to Police Station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 01/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Beerwah and further investigation started.

**Rs 34,500 fine recovered from SoPs violators in Ramban****STATE TIMES NEWS**

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Saturday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 34,500 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 78,34,000.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr. Suresh informed that as many as 908 persons were administered second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Saturday. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 2,530 samples including 618 RT-PCR and 1,912 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccines to 908 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.



**Two theft cases solved; three arrested, stolen goods recovered****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU/UDHAMPUR: Police on Saturday solved two theft cases by arresting three accused and recovered stolen goods from their possession.

As per the details, a complainant namely Ankur Gupta, son of Boshan Gupta, resident of Krishna Nagar, Jammu lodged a written complaint at Police Post Canal stating that on December 29, 2021 some unknown thieves entered his house in broad day-light at about 2 PM and decamped with Rs 40000 cash and 7-8 Tolas gold. FIR No. 01/2022 under sections 454/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Nowabad and investigation started. After this special police teams of Police Post Canal Road under supervision of DySP HQs Swati Sharma were constituted. The team led by SHO Police Station Nowabad Insp. Rajesh Khajuria assisted by Incharge Police Post Canal Road PSI Ishfaq Kasana, with strenuous efforts and help of CCTV footages of the area, rounded up a suspect namely Sahl Mashli alias Bata, son of Arshad Mashli, resident of Ustad Mohalla. During questioning, accused confessed the crime and on his disclosure stolen gold worth Rs 2-2.5 lakh were recovered from his possession. The overall arrest and recoveries were made under supervision of SP City North Kulbir Handa.

Meanwhile, Udhampur Police worked out theft case under jurisdiction of Police Station Udhampur within 24 hours of its registration and arrested accused persons namely Gafoor, son of Yousuf, resident of Balyal, Udhampur and Sadiq Mohd, son of Shah Mohd, resident of Garnai, Udhampur. Based on complaint of theft/burglary in the shop of one Ankush Sharma from Gole Mela, Udhampur, a team headed by SHO Police Station Udhampur Insp. Chaman Gorkha under the supervision of Anwaar ul Haq Addl SP Udhampur and Sahil Mahajan DySP HQs Udhampur conducted raids in different suspected locations. During raids, some suspects were zeroed in by police and on sustained interrogation, two of them broke down and confessed their offence. On disclosure of accused persons, stolen items like ply-board sheets, GI Tin sheets, Pipes etc valuing more than Rs 70,000 were recovered. FIR No. 03/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Udhampur and further investigation of case is going on.

**9 bovines rescued; two vehicles seized****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: In a massive drive against bovine smuggling, Jammu Police has rescued 9 bovines in two different vehicles during Naka checking at Ban Toll Plaza. Two different vehicles (JK19A/0380 and JK02W/9851) were seized by Police Station Nagrota. In this regard, two different FIRs No 02/2022 under sections 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA and FIR No 477/2021 under sections 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA was registered at Police Station Nagrota.

Two persons were also arrested who were identified as Shamus Din Loon, son of Rehmat Ullah Loon, resident of Dooligam, District Ramban, driver of vehicle (JK19A/0380) and Mohd Rafiq, son of Abdul Rehman, resident of Amar Chashma, Patnitop District Ramban, driver of vehicle (JK02W/9851). The arrests and recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Insp. Vishav Pratap Singh under supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh. The whole operation was done under the close supervision of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

**Two nabbed with 15.3 Kg poppy straw****STATE TIMES NEWS**

RAMBAN: In furtherance to tightening noose on narcotics smugglers under Operation Sanjeevani, police foiled a narcotics smuggling bid at Naka.

During routine checking, police party at Naka Nashri intercepted a motorcycle Hero Deluxe (PB11BW 4533) for checking, which was plying from Srinagar to Punjab.
