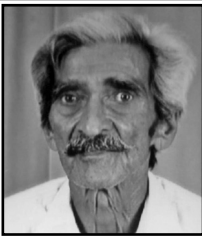

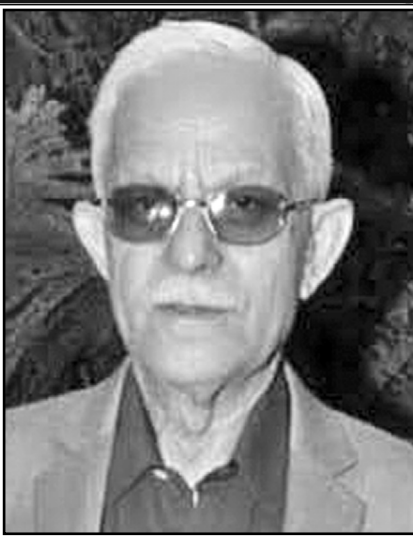

CRIMEREPORT

14 gamblers arrested, stake money seized; notorious drug peddler detained under PSA

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against social crimes, Police in Baramulla have arrested 14 gamblers and seized stake money from their possession. Besides, a notorious drug peddler was detained under PSA.

As per the details, acting on specific information, police parties from Police Station Kunzer and Police Station Pattan raided gambling sites at Takiya Batpora, Hardu Aboora, Hanjiwera Bala & Kripalpura Payeen following an input about gambling activities and apprehended 14 gamblers.

Officers have seized stake money of Rs 36,440 and playing cards from the gamblers. They have been arrested and shifted to respective police stations where they remain in custody

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and further investigation is in progress.

Moreover, a notorious drug peddler namely Muzamil Majeed Bhat alias Hashim son of Abdul Majeed Bhat resident of Mohalla Mir Sahib Baramulla was detained under PSA for his active involvement in drug peddling activities in Baramulla Town. Several cases under NDPS Act stands already registered against him. He has been lodged at Central Jail Kot Bilwal Jammu under detention orders received from Divisional Commissioner Kashmir.

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substances & illicit liquor recovered

KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Monday arrested two drug peddlers in Kulgam and recovered contraband substances and illicit liquor from their possession.

As per the details, on a specific input, a party from Police Station Qazigund conducted a raid at specific location in village Check Badwani Qazigund. During check-

ing, officers were able to recover 2Kgs of Poppy Straw and 45 bottles of illicit liquor from the residential house and arrested two persons identified as Nisar Ahmad Mir son of Gh Mohamad Mir resident of Telwani Anantnag AP Badwani Qazigund and Mohamad Yaseen Malik son of Gh Ahmad Malik resident of Chek Badwani Qazigund. They have been shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 12/2022 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Qazigund and investigation is in progress.

Absconder arrested

THANAMANDI: Police on Monday arrested an absconder who was evading his arrest in a case with a warrant of arrest was also issued against him by court.

The accused have been identified as Wasad Shah, son of Suleman Shah resident of Mangota village in Thanamandi who was absconding since 2019 in case FIR No 102/2019 and a warrant of arrest under section 512 CrPC was issued against him by the Court of JMJC Thanamandi.

Police in an official press statement informed that a team of Police Station Thanamandi headed by PSI Vikas Khullar Under the supervision of SHO Thanamandi Shoket Amin arrested the absconder from Mangota area and produced the absconder before the Hon'ble Court.

SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that taking investigations and legal proceedings in a case to a logical conclusion are one of the main priority of Rajouri police for which arrest of absconders is made as per law of land.

He said that a number of absconders have been arrested in Rajouri district in recent past and the action shall continue in future also.

3 missing minor boys recovered, reunited with families

SAMBA: Police on Monday recovered 03 missing minor boys hailing from District Reasi and reunited them with their families.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Samba while on routine patrolling duty in its jurisdictional area, found three minor boys roaming near Veer Bhumi Park, NH Samba. On questioning by the Police about their residential particulars/family members, they disclosed their identities as Tanveer Ahmed Bhat, son of Mashooq Ahmed Bhat; Nadeem Ahmed Bhat, son of Sharief Bhat and Azhar Ahmed, son of Bashir Ahmed Bhat; all residents of Village and Tehsil Thuroo, District Reasi.

Since all the children were minor and there was every apprehension that they could fall prey of the Anti Social Elements, SHO Samba, Inspr Deepak Jasrotia immediately took cognizance into the matter and contacted his counterpart SHO Arnas, District Reasi who in turn intimated that all the three minor boys were went missing from their respective homes and a case FIR No 11/2022 was registered at Police

Station Arnas in this regard.

Accordingly, all three minor boys were produced before Child Welfare Committee (CWC), Samba and thereafter handed over to Arnas Police/ Guardians after completing all the legal formalities.

Man held for illicit distillation, 50 liters Lahan & 5 Ltrs Desi Liquor Seized

KISHTWAR: Police in its continued drive against the consumption/production of illicit liquor menace in the district, Kishtwar Police destroyed 50 liters of Lahan, 05 liters Desi liquor seized and arrested 1 person at Padyarna area of Kishtwar.

As per the details, a party of Police Post padyarna developed a specific information of sale and production of Desi illicit liquor at Padyarna area. Acting swiftly a party of Police Party Padyarna headed by In-Charge Police Post PSI Ankush Sharma alongwith team under the supervision of Dy.SP Hqrs Kishtwar Satish Kumar raided the suspected location and arrested 01 person at Padyarna area of Kishtwar and seized 05 liter of Desi illicit liquor and nd 50 liter of Lahan destroyed on the spot.

The arrested person has been identified as Prithvi Nath, son of Gayan Chand, resident of Padyarna area of Kishtwar. FIR No. 11/2022 under section 48 A Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Kishtwar.

Foetus found in Udhampur hospital; enquiry ordered
