JAMMU: "Timely financial assistance from the Labour Department not only ended all my woes in the wake of Covid pandemic but it proved to be a boon for me and my family in the times of pain and distress" maintained Balwant Raj, a labourer from R S Pura, who on Friday extended gratitude to Jammu and Kashmir government for providing him monetary benefit under the Labour Department's scheme.

He said that during the Covid-19 lockdown I had no job to feed my family besides bearing their other basic expenditures but then the Labour department came as a blessing for us in the shape of financial assistance which brought my life back on track.

The department also took care of education of my children by providing them scholarship for study as without this much needed support I wouldn't have been able to educate my wards.

Not only me but there are number of labourers in J&K who are availing these benefits from the Labour department under various ongoing schemes which has made their lives easier and comfortable, asserted Balwant while speaking about the reach of government schemes to the people.

Mentioning about his worst days due to extreme poverty and lack of income ventures, Balwant recalled that how attending a camp, organized by the Labour Department at Phinder village of R S Pura, proved to be a turning point in his life when he came to know regarding various schemes launched by the government for welfare of labour community. He also had words of praise for the officials of the department for guiding him properly in getting the financial assistance within the shortest possible time.

Additional District Development Commissioners, Asstt Commissioners Development, Asstt Commissioners Panchayat, Executive Engineers and BDOs of District Rajouri and Poonch were present in the meeting. Director Jammu RDD Mumtaz Ali, Jt Director Planning, Tribal Affairs, Shama un Ahmed and SE Rural Engineering Wing were also present. Mandeep exhorted upon the field functionaries of Rural Development Department for immediate tendering of balance works of tribal affairs department under rural development sector. She also set a deadline of 3 days for upload-

ing on MGNREGA portal all the works required to be taken up under convergence between funding provided by Tribal Affairs Department and MGNREGA.

She reviewed the work wise status of works including trending process and execution with focus on quality, convergence model and active efforts being made by the department in tribal areas.

Progress was reviewed for 12 Cluster Tribal Model Villages in Rajouri and Poonch under which funds have been provided by the tribal affairs department both under UT Capex and Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The works related to rural

infrastructure including connectivity have been prioritised. The secretary was informed that a total of 554 works have been taken up in district Rajouri and more than 300 works in district Poonch which include rural connectivity, educational infrastructure, Anganwadi Centres, rural housing, sanitation and other local works. More than 40 villages are covered under 12 clusters. Further, the scheme of CTMV is being replaced by Integrated Village Development Scheme under which infrastructure development will have 100% funding by the Central Government. List of villages from both the

districts has been submitted to Government of India for release of funds.

Commissioner Secretary RDD and Secretary Tribal Affairs Department discussed various contours of convergence between schemes of both the department for maximum benefit to tribal population in twin border districts. It was also discussed that plan formulation for 2022-23 shall be completed immediately.
