Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway

&

Cost: ₹ 1,700 Cr. | Length: 77 km | Amritsar-Ghoman-Tanda National Highway

Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway (NE-5 & NE-5A)

- Travel time from Delhi to Amritsar to reduce from 8 hrs to nearly half.
- Travel time from Delhi to Katra to reduce from 12 hrs to nearly half.
- Saving in fuel and reduction in pollution.
- Expressway to connect key Sikh Religious sites at Shri Harmandir Sahib Amritsar, Shri Ber Sahib (Sultanpur Lodhi), Shri Goindwal Sahib, Shri Khadoor Sahib, Shri Tarn-Taran Sahib to culminate & the holy shrine of Mata Vaishno Devi in Katra.
- Boost to tourism and new investment opportunities.
- Better connectivity to the industrial & commercial Centers of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu and Kashmir will result in significant reduction in logistics costs and connectivity between agricultural centers to increase farmers' income.
- Each end of the state to be connected to the each corner of the state and capital of the country.
- New job opportunities will be created.
- Easy access to large markets for agricultural and other local produce.
- 4 Lane Access Controlled Green Field Expressway which can be extended upto 8 Lanes.

Amritsar-Ghoman-Tanda National Highway (NH-503)

- Being 4 laned as part of Amritsar – Una – Bhota Economic Corridor (NH-503).
- Would enhance connectivity from Amritsar to Himachal Pradesh.
- Serve as feeder route for Amritsar – Bhatinda – Jamnagar Economic Corridor, Delhi – Amritsar – Katra Expressway & Jammu – Delhi National Corridor.
- Improve connectivity to historically and religiously important towns like Ghoman, Shri Hargobindpur, Pul Pukhta in Punjab and Una in Himachal Pradesh.
- Would provide alternate connectivity to international border including the Katarpur Corridor.
- Elimination of Railway Crossing.
- Additional road safety by providing flyover and vehicle under pass.
