11 thieves arrested across J&K; stolen items recovered**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU/SRINAGAR: Seven theft cases were solved on Saturday in Jammu & Kashmir with arrest of eleven thieves and all stolen items were recovered.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Bakshi Nagar by one Rashmi, wife of Suraj, resident of Old Roulki, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu regarding theft at her house by some unknown thieves. On other hand, another complaint was received at Police Station Bakshi Nagar regarding theft in house of a woman namely Kusum Lata Dutta, wife of R P Mehta, resident of Gurha Bakshi Nagar, Jammu. FIR No. 190/2021 under sections 457/380 of IPC and FIR No. 02/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC respectively were registered at Police Stations Bakshi Nagar.

After this, police team led by SHO Bakshi Nagar Insp. Harjeet Singh under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar, with strenuous efforts and help of CCTV footages of area, finally rounded-up two suspects namely Amit Mehra, son of Balwinder Singh and Deepak Singh, son of Ram Singh, both residents of Bhagwati Nagar and were arrested in FIR No. 190/2021. During intensive questioning, they confessed his involvement in crime and on their disclosure, stolen gold items weighing 20 gm were recovered by Police. On other hand, another suspect namely Shub Kumar, son of Baba Ram, resident of Jalpai Gudi, West Bengal was rounded up in FIR No. 02/2022. During intensive questioning, he confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure, all stolen items were also recovered which included 40,000 cash; two Apple Mobiles; gold items worth about Rs 1 lakh. The overall arrests and recoveries in both the cases were made under supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar.



Meanwhile, in a major achievement by Poonch police, three persons were arrested alongwith stolen money. As per officials, a complaint was received from a shopkeeper regarding theft of money from his shop located in Quila Market Poonch during broad daylight when he was out for offering Namaz prayers. FIR No. 05/2022 under section 380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Poonch and a party led by SHO Poonch Sureshwar Dev Singh under the supervision of Deputy SP HQ Nawaz Ahmed and overall supervision of SSP Poonch Rohit Baskotra conducted detailed enquiry and after identification, arrested three suspects from different locations. During investigation, all three accused confessed their crime and on their disclosure, police also recovered stolen money and other items. The arrested accused were identified as Mohd Rashid, son of Abdul Hamid, resident of Sukha Katha; Mohd Qassim, son of Mohd Sharief and Sayeed Mujtaba alia Chottu, son of Afzal Hussain, both residents of Ward-1 Poonch. Police further said that accused were involved in



other theft cases also and had stolen money even from religious places in Poonch town.

Moreover, Police in Ganderbal also solved two burglary cases by arresting five accused and recovered stolen property worth lakhs. On December 12, 2021, Police Station Ganderbal received a complaint from Head Master GGHS Wakura regarding burglary during intervening night of December 11-12, 2021 at GGHS Wakura. Moreover, on December 23, 2021, Police Station Ganderbal received one complaint from Manzoor Ahmad Ahanger, son of Gh Mohd Ahanger, resident of Chanapora, Bandipora regarding burglary during intervening night of December 22-23, 2021 at Govt Middle School Chundina. Accordingly, FIR Nos 224/2021 and 228/2021 respectively under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Ganderbal and investigation started. Soon, special team was constituted by SSP Ganderbal Nikhil Borkar led by Incharge Police Post Shadipora under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Ganderbal Abdul Majid. The team, acting swiftly, cracked both the cases and arrested five accused involved in crime, who were identified as Javid Ahmad Mir, son of Gh Ahmad Mir, resident of Nabirpora Bandipora; Mohd Shafiq Lone, son of Gh Mohammad Lone, resident of Hathlangoo Sopore; Ali Mohd Dar, son of Mohammad Afzal Dar, resident of Muslim Abad Bandipora and Mehraj-udin Matta, son of Abdul Jabbar Matta, Zubair Ahmad Sofi, son of Abdul Hamid Sofi, both residents of Shair colony Sopore.

On their disclosure, 16 Exide Batteries worth Rs 1.40 lakh, a 10 KVA Generator, 2 oxygen Cylinders, 15 Iron sheets, 1 Welding Machine, 1 iron-cutter, 8 Iron Angles worth approximately Rs 2,35,000 were recovered. Moreover, tools and vehicles used in burglaries were also recovered and seized by Police.

JAMMU: Police on Saturday arrested a drug peddler and recovered 177 gm Charas from his possession.

As per details, a police team led by Incharge Police Post Chowk Chabutra, SI Jyoti Choudhary apprehended a drug-peddler, identified as Aditya Gupta, son of Ashok Kumar Gupta, resident of House No. 127, Lane No. 02, Talab Tillo, District Jammu and recovered 177 gm Charas like substances from his possession. He was arrested on the spot and a case under relevant sections of law was registered against him.
