

# J&K Judicial Academy organises workshop on Juvenile Justice Act, 2015

JAMMU: Jammu and Kashmir Judicial Academy under the patronage of Justice Tashi Rabstan, Chief Justice (Acting), High Court of J&K and Ladakh and Patron-in-Chief, J&K Judicial Academy, organized one day workshop on "Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection) Act, 2015 with special reference to Constitutional Vision of Justice and Concept of Social Justice, Child Abuse Prevention, Protection and Redress" for Principal Magistrates and Juvenile Justice Boards besides officers from Social Welfare Department, Jammu province here on Saturday.

The event was held under the guidance of Justice Sindhu Sharma, Chairperson, Governing Committee for

J&K Judicial Academy and Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul, Justice Javed Iqbal Wani and Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal, members of Governing Committee for J&K Judicial Academy.

Shahzad Azeem, Director, J&K Judicial Academy, presented an overview of the programme. The courts have special responsibility to deal with such cases with extra cautious approach to ensure proper justice and rehabilitation of such children. All the stakeholders need to ensure that children in conflict with

the law are treated in a manner substantially different than adults at all stages of the proceedings, he added.

In the first technical session, Pawan Dev Kotwal, District and Sessions Judge (President, District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Jammu) stressed that approach of the officers of social welfare department and the judicial system must be aimed at addressing the vulnerabilities of the children and ensuring their rehabilitation. He observed that idea

behind rehabilitation is that people are not criminals by birth and have every right to get a chance to mend their character and reintegrated with society to lead a dignified life. All this can be possible with the collective efforts of all stakeholders of the society, said the expert.

In the second technical session, Pawan Dev Kotwal deliberated upon the role of District Child Protection Units (DCPU's) and linkages between DCPU, Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs) and Child Welfare Committees (CWC).

Later, an interactive session was held during which the participants deliberated and discussed various aspects of the subject topic and raised queries which were satisfactorily settled by the resource persons.

# HC dismisses petition of School seeking quashment of disconnecting electricity supply

JAMMU: Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court dismissed the petition filed by JK Montessori School seeking quashment of action of the respondents in illegally disconnecting the electric supply to the petitioner-school in flagrant violation to the provisions of the J&K Electricity Act, 2010 and Rules framed there-under and without providing 15 days notice in writing as per the provisions of Section 50(1) of the J&K Electricity Act, 2010.

Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal while dismissing the petition, observed that It is trite law that ordinarily relief under Article 226 of the constitution of India is not available, if efficacious alternative remedy is available to any aggrieved per-

son. Where statutory remedy is created by law, the writ petition should not be entertained ignoring the statutory dispensation. It is also a well recognized principle of law that where a right or liability is created by a statute, which provides for speedy remedy for enforcing it, the remedy provided by the said statute alone should be availed of. Undoubtedly, it is equally well settled that this canon of law is not free of exceptions and alternative remedy is not a bar to the entertaining of writ petition filed for enforcement of any of the fundamental rights or where there has been violation of principles of natural justice or where the order under challenge wholly without jurisdiction or verse of the statute providing for alternative remedy is otherwise under challenge. As such, when the statutory remedy of appeal is available

to the petitioner, this writ petition is not maintainable, I have carefully perused the grounds urged in the writ petition, I do not find it a case, which is covered by the exceptions to the general rules that in the face of alternate remedy, the Constitutional Court would not entertain the writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal further observed that the respondents have refuted the claim of the petitioner and have tried to justify the imposition of excess load penalty by pleading that the petitioner school is functioning in two premises having one metered connection and another without meter, which fact has never been denied by the petitioner. This fact has also been admitted by the petitioner by applying for fresh electricity connection in the

name of JK Millennium International School. The person seeking relief under discretionary writ jurisdiction must come to the court with clean hands. It is a settled principle of law that one who demands equity must do equity. On this count also the writ petition is not maintainable as the petitioner has not pleaded correct facts.

High Court further ordered that having regard to the fact that petitioner has been pursuing its claim before this court by filing this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, as such, if the petitioner would wish to avail the remedy of statutory appeal as per the Act, supra, the Appellate Authority shall consider the same without making reference to the period of limitation and, till then, no punitive action/recovery will be taken against/from the petitioner.
