


Road Safety Week 2023, Swachhta Pakhwada takes off in Doda district

DODA: Motor Vehicles Department (MVD) on Wednesday organised a Road Safety Awareness Program to mark the inauguration of Road Safety Week 2023, Swachhta Pakhwada being held from January 11 to January 17. A Joint Traffic Naka was also established at 9th KM on Batote Doda National Highway near Assar.

The ADC addressed the Drivers/Transporters/Gen Public about Road Safety and appealed
