DM Doda issues order for mandatory disclosure of details of tenants, installation of CCTV cameras in shops

DODA: District Magistrate Doda, Vishesh Paul Mahajan, has issued an order under Section 144 CrPC, asking all landlords, property owners, vehicle owners, shop and commercial business establishment owners, attorney holders, and persons in charge of properties in any capacity located within the jurisdiction of the district to submit detailed particulars of their tenants to the concerned police station within 7 days.

The order has been issued with the aim of ensuring public safety and preventing anti-national and anti-social elements from seeking hideouts in residential areas under the guise of tenants and domestic helpers.

The landlords and property owners,

along with the tenants, have been made accountable under the order. It also clarifies that arrangements such as paying guest and subletting are also covered under the order, and owners who have allowed jhuggies on their land are also required to disclose the details as per the declaration form. The SHO concerned will maintain a separate register for the purpose.

The declaration form can be found on the district website, as individual notice cannot be served. Any person found contravening this order will be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

DM Doda has taken this step to ensure public safety and keep a check on anti-national and anti-social elements,

who might seek hideout in residential areas in the guise of tenants/domestic helpers. This move is expected to help the law enforcement agencies in maintaining peace and order in the district.

The District Magistrate of Doda has issued an order mandating the installation of CCTV cameras in all shops, establishments, restaurants, hotels, garages, and scrap dealers on National Highway, as well as in main markets and other important roads within the jurisdiction of the district. Owners have been given 15 days to comply with the order; failure to do so will be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code. The Senior Superintendent of Police has been tasked with ensuring the implementation of this order.

With the notification of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by Government of India and subsequent notification of Jammu & Kashmir Government Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws 2019, it is incumbent / compulsory for all waste generators including households, shops, commercial establishments, Hotels, Institutional Establishments, vegetable / fruit / flower / mutton / meat markets etc. to segregate waste at source and also to strictly ensure management, segregation, recycling and reuse of Municipal Solid Waste strictly as per aforementioned rules.

"Fine" means penalty imposed on waste generators or operators of waste processing and disposal facilities under the bye-laws for non-compliance of the directions contained in these rules and/or bye-laws

If any waste generator, who fails to comply with the duties entrusted upon him under rule 4 of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, shall be liable to pay fine under these bye-laws. The quantum of fine shall be imposed in accordance with the offences mentioned in the Schedule.

The general public through the medium of this notice is informed to fine / Penalty for in compliance of Solid Waste Management rules 2016 within limits of Jammu Municipal Corporation as per the following rates:

Notice for Prohibiting Production, Stocking, Distribution, Sale & Use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) Items

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification No G.S.R. 571(E) dated 12th August 2021 vide which manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic (SUP) items shall be prohibited with effect from the July 01, 2022.

As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), "The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July, 2022:


(a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration;

(b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

As per Rules 4(1)(c) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic, shall not be less than one hundred and twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December 2022.

This Notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockists, Retailers, Shopkeepers, e-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Market place/ Shopping Centres / Cinema Houses/ Tourist locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items.

Any non-compliance in this regard will attract penal action as per Jammu & Kashmir Non-Biodegradable Material (Management, Handling and Disposal) Act, 2007 and as per its subsequent amendment by Government of India vide notification No. S.O. 1229(E) dated 31-03-2020 in above which may include fine up to the tune of Rs. 50000/- and punishment for a term which may be extended for a month or both.

Section 3 (B) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, provide as:-

"Bulk Waste Generator" means and includes buildings occupied by the Central government departments or undertakings, State government departments or undertakings, local bodies, public sector undertakings or private companies, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, colleges, universities, other educational institutions, hotels, hostels, commercial establishments, markets, places of worship, stadia and sports complexes having an average waste generation rate exceeding 100 kg per day;

In view of the above,

All resident welfare and market associations, all gated communities, and institutions with more than 5,000 sq. m. area, shall through the medium of this notice pay Rs. 5,000/- per month as user charges to Jammu Municipal Corporation for collection, transportation & processing of their segregated waste.

Standard Operating Procedure for Scrap Dealers

With the notification of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by the Government of India and subsequent notification of Jammu & Kashmir Government Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws 2019, it is incumbent upon all that "no waste generator shall throw, burn or bury the solid waste generated by him, on public places, open public spaces, outside his premises or in drain or water bodies.

According to SWM Rules-2016 ULBs should involve communities in waste management. In this respect SWM Rules-2016 calls for registration of waste pickers and waste dealers and providing the training on Solid Waste Management to waste pickers and waste collectors. Scrap dealers/ Waste aggregators / rag pickers are an essential part of waste management chain and play a vital role to improve the circular economy in waste management sector.

Hence, it has been observed that some of the scrap dealers are not following the rules as notified in SWM rules-2016. As such, following instructions/ Standard Operation Procedure is hereby outlined to be strictly complied with all the scrap dealers falling which action under rules will be initiated against them.

Every scrap dealer must ensure:


- Proper segregation and safe storage of the collected waste.
- Proper area should be earmarked for category wise scrap storage.
- Burning of Solid waste/plastic waste strictly prohibited and is punishable offence as per the Solid Waste Management Rules-2016.
- Installation of boundary / View cutter up to 10 feet height of the premises so that view of the premises could be avoided.
- Boundary wall should be fabricated of GI sheet with 5 mm thickness and painted with green color.
- For proper housekeeping and hygiene of earmarked area and beautification of the city should not be affected by the storage center.
- Proper mechanism of fire and safety equipments must be available at segregation and storage unit proportionate to the waste accommodated in the premises.
- Every scrap dealer to ensure sale of the segregated material to authorized recycler only.
- Every scrap dealer to register himself/his firm with Jammu Municipal Corporation.

• Payment of monthly user charges to Jammu Municipal Corporation on time. Tariff given as below:

Sr. No.	Storage Area	User Charges/ Month
1.	Up to 500 sq. ft	1000/-
2.	501 sq. ft to 1000 sq. ft	1500/-
3.	Above 1000 sq. ft	2500/-

- Proper disposal of collected Multi Layered Plastic /packing Material.
- Maintaining of logbook for collected and sale material.
- Maintaining the record of rag-pickers engaged by them.
- Welfare measures for rag-pickers viz. linkage of rag-pickers with various social services and insurance schemes viz.: -

- Ayushman Bharat Yojana
- Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana
- Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana
- Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana
- Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana
- Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana
