IT Deptt hosts online services training for Master Trainers

JAMMU: In an effort to provide fair, transparent, and time-bound delivery of services, the Information Technology Department in collaboration with the Directorate of School Education Jammu on Sunday organised a day-long Capacity Building Program for Master Trainers on the usage of online services of various departments at Teacher Bhawan Jammu.

More than 250 teachers from the 10 districts of Jammu division were trained as Master Trainers who will in turn train teachers and other stakeholders in their districts, taking online services and their usage to the grassroot level.

During the workshop, the master trainers were informed and sensitised about 400 plus G2C services being offered by the Government, Rapid Assessment System (RAS) for citizen real-time feedback, UMANAG platform for mobile Governance, Dig-locker for safe and secure storage space, MySchemes for central reposi-

tory of government schemes, portals such as e-Unnat, Janbhagidari, Apki Zameen Apki Nigrahi etc.

It was noted that e-Governance is penetrating down to the Panchayat level, and training and capacity-building programs such as this are imperative to ensure the percolation of these online services to every citizen of UT of J&K.

Additional Secretary, IT Department, Satish Sharma, who was the chief guest on the occasion said that the idea was to take the technological developments to the grassroots level

and involve every citizen in the process. He thanked the Director School Education Jammu, Dr. Ravi Shankar Sharma for the prompt cooperation and stated that such training would be held in the future as well to train the teachers and other stakeholders, for popularising the online services and creating awareness about them.

The training sessions were carried out by the experts of NIC/JaKeGA/IT department; Shashank, Showkat Ali, Imran Sufi, Aijaz and Manager IT Cell Naved from the Department of Information

Technology, J&K.

CEO Jammu, Suraj Singh Rathore presented the welcome address and the formal note of thanks, thanking the chief guest, Additional Secretary and the Guest of Honour, Under Secretary Deptt. of IT for providing insight and valuable guidance on the subject to the trainees.

Water, power supply restored to normal across Kashmir

SRINAGAR: After recent Snowfall affected road connectivity and basic facilities in some areas of Kashmir Division, the advance measures put in place by the Administration helped to respond immediately to any emergency arising due to Snowfall and restore services at the earliest. The Divisional Commissioner's Office in a report on Sunday said that the Mechanical Engineering Department (MED) cleared 5423 Kms of roads under priority- I and 5423 Kms, 3045 Kms under priority II and III which constitutes 99.63 percent and 89 percent respectively.

Similarly, the R&B depart-

ment cleared 3760 Kms out of 4471, therefore restoring 85 percent of road length across Kashmir Division. Also, PMGSY completed Snow clearance on 518.1 Kms which constitutes 74 percent of roads under its jurisdiction to be cleared. While ULB completed 100 percent of the total 885 Kms road length in all its 40 Urban Local Bodies, Kashmir.

Regarding the restoration of PHE Water Supply Schemes (WSSs), it was informed that a total of 86 schemes were affected by Snowfall out of which 68 schemes have been restored while the work on the rest of the schemes is going on and shall be restored soon.

KPDCL reported the outage

on 78, 11kv lines on January 13 of which 98 percent have been restored while the restoration processes of the remaining part continues.

In view of inclement weather, SMC has announced that 80 permanent de-watering stations and 122 mobile pumps are fully functional to meet any eventuality. After the recent snowfall, SMC informed that 28 De-watering Mobile pumps were pressed in service in Srinagar city on 13th January besides it said that the Control room under the supervision of Joint Commissioner; Works has been already established.

Regarding the availability of food grains in the valley to meet the requirement, FCS&CA

today stated that against 70,000 MTS storage capacity, 59347 MTS of food grains is available in FCI godowns.

The FCSCA has dumped 100% foodgrains in 796 Snow-bound centers in 9 districts. It informed that 272015 LPG cylinders sufficient for 23 days, 7089 KLS MS for 23 days, 6357 KLS HSD for 11 days and 1599 KLS SKO for 1 month are also available in Kashmir Division.

While divulging the information regarding availability of medicine in Kashmir Division, the Health Department has briefed divisional administration that all necessary/emergency drugs are available across in all hospitals.

Advisor Bhatnagar visits Gharana Wetland Conservation Reserve, inspects ongoing works

JAMMU: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Rajeev Rai Bhatnagar on Sunday visited the Gharana Wetland Conservation Reserve, R.S Pura and reviewed the progress on ongoing developmental works there.

During the visit, the Advisor took a detailed round of the wetland and took onspot assessment of all the ongoing construction works.

Interacting with the officers during the visit, Advisor Bhatnagar remarked that in coming years this place will be developed into a popular bird sanctuary with all facilities and services to make it one of the most attractive tourist attractions of Jammu region.

He added that it is our prime duty to maintain the integrity of wetlands as they form the main habitat for migratory as well as other bird species. The Advisor on the occasion directed the officers to complete the works on approach road, parking bay, chain link fencing drains as well as other facilities on time. "Utilities need to be provided to the local visitors

as well tourists", said Advisor. Pertinently, the Gharana Wetland Conservation Reserve holds around 65 species of birds, among which around 20 are migratory bird species coming from Central Asia, Mongolia, Russia and other places.

The most common birds which attract visitors are bar-headed geese, com-

mon teals, Indian moorhens, gadwalls, green shanks flocks, purple swamp-hens Bar-headed Goose, Northern Pintail, Northern Shoveler, Black-winged Stian, Grey Heron, White-breasted Ibis, Pied Kingfisher and Eurasian Wigeon, Woolly-necked Storks and other species.

During the sidelines of the visit, the Advisor also interacted with the Sarpanch as well as locals of the Gharana area and discussed with them the issues and concerns pertaining to their area.

While interacting with them, the Advisor highlighted that the Gharana Wetland's surrounding villages will benefit from the eco-and-border tourism in the area. He also assured them that all of their genuine issues will be addressed on priority.
