

Biotechnology Research - IIM-J, AIIMS-J, IIT Delhi join hands

JAMMU: Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Jammu and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jammu collectively explored the possibilities to undertake research and facilitate innovative products/ processes in the field of Biotechnology in J&K, on the occasion of this Start-up day, here on Tuesday.

IIM Jammu and IIT Delhi co-hosted a session on Biotechnology Ignition Grant (BIG) by BIRAC at IIM Jammu, Canal Road campus. The initiative was carried out by IIM Jammu Foundation for Entrepreneurship, Innovation, and Skill Development, the business incubator of IIM Jammu, under the leadership of Prof. B. S. Sahay, Director IIM Jammu. The program

was attended by students & faculty members of IIM Jammu as well as doctors of AIIMS, Jammu.

Prior to the main session, a canvassing regarding the Grant was done at AIIMS Jammu in the morning, for the benefit of all the doctors of the institute. The session at AIIMS Jammu was organized by Dr. Pranay Mahajan, Hospital Administrator, AIIMS Jammu and chaired by Lt. Gen Sunil Kant, SM VSM

(Retd.), Medical Superintendent and Dean (Research), AIIMS Jammu.

The first speaker on the occasion included, Dr. Saket Chattopadhyay from FITT, the industry interface arm of IIT Delhi who deliberated on the entrepreneurial process, previously successful cases, and the BIRAC's BIG funding application process.

The second session was taken by the son of soil Mr. Arjun Gupta, Director of

Genetico, the grantee of the BIG grant (2019 chapter). His project was based on data analytics of hereditary diseases. The welcome address of the session was delivered by Dr. Prateek Jain, chairperson, CEI, IIM Jammu. The session deliberated upon various research ideas and the possibilities of taking these to the grant stage with the support of the students and incubator of IIM Jammu.

While talking to the audience, the speakers emphasized the importance of taking up meaningful synergies to take the research projects to the culmination stage. The session was also attended by the executive MBA students of IIM Jammu through a VC broadcast.

The vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Vivek Sharma, Chief Innovation Officer, IIM Jammu.

2.5 lakh farmers to be trained in agri-skills: Atal Dulloo

JAMMU: Additional Chief Secretary (ACS), Agriculture Production Department, Atal Dulloo, chaired a meeting to review Skill Development in Agriculture and its allied sectors here on Tuesday at Civil Secretariat.

The meeting discussed the recommendations of the Dr Mangla Rai Apex Committee Report, which aims to provide skill improvement and entrepreneurship-related training to 2.5 lakh farmers engaged in agriculture and allied sectors in J&K. The trainings aim at increasing their income and overall economy of Jammu & Kashmir.

During the meeting, a presentation on the Holistic Agriculture Development Programme was given, which outlined the proposed courses for farmers. A total of 29 skill training programs were proposed, including 21 in Agriculture and Horticulture, 3 in Agricultural Engineering, 4 in Forestry, 3 in Sericulture, 6 in Veterinary & Animal

Sciences, 2 in Fisheries and 1 in Rural Business Management.

Atal Dulloo stated that the main focus of the administration is to increase seed production.

He also highlighted the potential for fast-growing sectors such as trout production and mushroom cultivation to increase farmers' income.

The ACS emphasised the importance of providing training on food processing, value addition and market linkage as well as fostering a culture of self-employment and entrepreneurship in Jammu & Kashmir.

He suggested that participants be provided with certificates upon completion of the training courses, and also suggested that entrepreneurship development programmes should be included in the course curriculum.

He said that sensitisation of the departmental staff is being done and will be completed by April this year.

He directed that the curriculum design be finalised in a month, resource persons for

which be identified and trained by March, and a training calendar for 2023-24 be released subsequently.
