The meeting was graced by K. K. Sharma, Director Agriculture Department, Jammu Division, who is also Mission Director for IYOM-2023 for Jammu Division of J&K. The event was also attended by Dr. S K K Gupta, Director Extension, SKUAST-Jammu, Senior Scientists of SKUAST-Jammu, Senior Officer of NABARD, Senior Project Manager, Jammu & Kashmir Rural Livelihood Mission (JKRLM), Heads of



CGM, NABARD, Jammu and Kashmir Regional Office, Dr. Ajay K Sood chairing the meet.

NGOs working in Jammu viz. Kristu Jyoti Social Welfare Society, KYASC, JKDUCL & YMC. Dr. A. K. Sood, Chief General Manager, NABARD, Jammu and Kashmir Regional Office welcomed the dignitaries to the programme and appraised the house about the campaign of Govt. of India to take millets to every corner of the world and briefed about the rationale behind UN declaring 2023 as

International Year of Millets as the world is facing existential crisis of food insecurity and water scarcity.

He emphasized on how FPOs can become a launching spot for millets as minor produce. Dr Sood enlisted main focus points for deliberations by

the house. A detailed presentation on current status of millets in India and scope for NABARD interventions for the promotion of millets in UTs of J&K was given by NABARD. medicinal value of millets.

Dr. S K Gupta spoke about importance of millets and role of SKUAST in promotion of millets in Jammu & Kashmir. He emphasized on possible collaboration of NABARD with SKUAST-J & Agriculture Department, Jammu for mainstreaming millets into food habits of people of J&K through transfer of technology and innovation.

DRAFT JAMMU AND KASHMIR PROHIBITION OF CHILD MARRIAGE RULES, 2023.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 19 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 (Central Act 6 of 2007), the Lieutenant Governor of J&K hereby makes the following Rules, namely:

- Short title:** These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Prohibition of Child Marriage Rules, 2023.
- Definition:** (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "Act" means the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 (Central Act 6 of 2007);
 - " Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - Words and Expressions used and not defined in these rules but defined in the Act shall have the meaning respectively assigned to them in the Act.
- Child Marriage Prohibition Officer:** The following officers of the various Departments of the Government shall act as Child Marriage Prohibition Officer in terms of Section 16(1) of the Act within their respective jurisdiction :
 - Chief Medical Officer.
 - Chief Education Officer.
 - Zonal Development Officer.
 - Block Medical Officer.
 - Block Development Officer.
 - Assistant Labour Commissioner.
 - Assistant Commissioner (Panchayat).
 - District Social Welfare Officer.
 - Child Development Protection Officer.
 - Tehsildar.
 - Naib Tehsildar.
- Duties and Functions of Child Marriage Prohibition Officer:** In addition to the duties and functions assigned to the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer under sub-section (3) of Section 16 of the Act, it shall be the duty of every Child Marriage Prohibition Officer:
 - to act immediately upon any information of solemnization of any child marriage that may be received through any mode of communication including written or oral i.e. through a letter, telephone, telegram, e-mail etc. or by any other means and forthwith initiate all necessary action;
 - to furnish quarterly return and statistics to the District Magistrate concerned and the Directorates of Social Welfare Jammu/ Kashmir in Form I;
 - to file petition before a Judicial Magistrate First class/ Metropolitan Magistrate for obtaining information prohibiting a Child Marriage.
 - to file petition for annulling a child marriage in District Court in case any of the contracting party to the marriage is a minor;
 - to file petition before the District Court for maintenance and residence to the female contracting party of the Marriage until her remarriage;
 - to file petition before the District Court for the custody and maintenance of children of the child marriage.
 - to file petition under Section 3(2) of the Act along with the child.
- Filing of the case:** Any person in the best interest of the child, may also file a petition through Child Marriage Prohibition Officer.
- Power of Child Marriage Prohibition Officer:** In terms of Section 16 (4) of the Act, the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer are invested with the powers of Police Officer as prescribed in Section 156, 160, 161, 165 and 175 of Criminal Procedure Code subject to the condition that such powers are exercised by the said officer herself/ himself within her/ his jurisdiction for taking cognizance of offences prescribed under the Act.
- Panchayat Core Committee:** The District Magistrate shall ensure that in every Panchayat, a Committee comprising of the following persons is constituted to assist the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer in obtaining information about such child marriages, in prevention of such ceremonies and in annulling of such marriages :

Sarpanch:	Chairperson Supervisor
Mission Poshan(Social Welfare):	Convener
Village Level Worker/ Secretary Panchayat :	Member
Head Master of the nearest school/Senior Teacher:	Member
(where there is no Head Master)	
One Women Ward Member:	Member
(If more than one Women Ward Member, the Senior most by age)	
- Duty of Local Priest:** It shall be the duty of local priests of any religion bestowed with the solemnization of marriages, to inform the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer of her/ his area about the likelihood of such Child Marriages and shall refrain from solemnizing such marriages with a view to prevent such instances of child marriage.
- Award:** The Government of Jammu and Kashmir may declare suitable awards for such persons on whose initiatives/ information the incident(s) of Child Marriages are prevented. The District Magistrates shall also felicitate such persons on suitable occasions of National importance.
