## DC Kathua reviews progress of PWD, Power Sector projects

Meanwhile, in a separate meeting, the Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of the Power Sector projects in the district. The PDD functionaries apprised the DC about the power scenario in the district and gave a detailed account of the physical and financial progress of works achieved under different schemes. The meeting was informed about PDD sector schemes under District CAPEX, DDC, BDC and PRI grants, ABDP etc and the DC directed the concerned to expedite the payment in case of completed works.
