JAMMU: Deputy Commissioner, Avny Lavasa on Monday visited M.A Stadium and reviewed on the spot the arrangements for Republic- Day 2023 celebration.

Commissioner JMC, Rahul Yadav; SSP, Chandan Kohli; Director School Education, Ravi Shanka; Deputy Director Information (PR) Dr Vikas Sharma along with senior functionaries from Police, Security, Jal Shakti, PDD, Health, Hospitality and Protocol, Sports and Youth Affairs and other concerned departments were present on the occasion.

Threadbare discussion was held with regard to the security arrangements, traffic regulation, seating arrangements, Full Dress

Rehearsal, decoration, Shahnai vadan, PAS, power and water supply, transport arrangements, sanitation, Medicare facilities, Barricading at venue of the function and other vital issues.

The DC inquired from the officers from security and police about the arrangements being put in place by their respective departments. She directed them to make fool-proof security arrangements in advance for the National event.

The Deputy Commissioner asked the Deputy Director Information to make the arrangements of Public Address System, Media coordination for proper coverage, Shehnai Vadan besides recommendation of commentators for the event.

The Deputy Commissioner also asked the concerned officials to complete the face lifting works well before the event. The DC instructed the Jammu Municipal Corporation to ensure cleanliness in and around the venue on the R-Day celebrations.

The JPDCL and Jal Shakti department were directed to ensure proper management of electricity

and water including water tankers at the venue.

The CMO was asked to ensure proper medical facilities along with staff and ambulances at the venue.

The Deputy Commissioner directed the Officers to ensure all related arrangements in advance and work in close coordination for the smooth conduct of Republic Day celebrations.

JAMMU: Principal Secretary, Skill Development Department (SDD), Dr Asgar Hassan Samoon on Monday chaired a meeting at Civil Secretariat to review the status of grievances and complaints received by the department on JKIGRAMS portal.

The meeting was informed that 21 grievances and complaints have been received on the portal till date, of which, most of them have been disposed off and remaining are being looked into for speedy redressal. Principal Secretary stressed upon the officers to ensure early redressal of all genuine grievances being registered by the public concerning SDD so that the purpose of the portal is met successfully and required feedback is obtained. He enjoined upon the officers that redressal of each complaint/grievance should be completed on the basis of ground report with cross examination of complaints, so that the complainant gets proper information as well as resolution for the same. He also asked the officers to ensure strict adherence to the prescribed guidelines while dealing with issues being registered on the portal. The meeting was attended by Mission Director, Skill Development Mission, J&K, Leena Padha; Director, Skill Development Department, Sudershan Kumar; Special Secretary SDD; Financial Advisor SDD; Secretary, Board of Technical Education, J&K and other concerned officials both in person and online.

Implementation of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission in J&K reviewed

JAMMU: Secretary, Health and Medical Education, Bhupinder Kumar on Monday reviewed implementation of flagship programme 'Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM)' in Jammu and Kashmir;

Additional Mission Director, ABDM, made a presentation regarding the milestones achieved and the targets set as part of scheme execution. It was informed that, so far, more than 50 lakh ABHA IDs have been created and 3500 health facilities have been registered under the Health Facility Registry (HFR). Secretary also reviewed the Hospital Health Professional Registration and asked the CMOs to ensure registration of all the Health Professionals on the designated portal within two weeks besides linking their Aadhar.

He said that the aim of ABDM is to develop support system for integrated digital health infrastructure of the country which shall bridge the existing gap among different stakeholders of Healthcare ecosystem through digital highways.

Regarding development of ecosystem for the digital mission, Secretary directed the officers to ensure that all the modules of the Health Management Information System (HMIS) including scan and share queue registration are rolled out in a time bound manner.

Secretary, while reviewing level of integration at block levels, stressed upon the participation by all the stakeholders. He asked the Principals of Government Medical Colleges and the Head of Departments to accomplish the task in a time bound manner so that intended objectives of the mission are realized for public welfare. He reiterated that proper digitization of health records shall be the only way to ensure delivery of quality health care delivery in a professional and accountable manner.

The meeting was attended by Mission Director NHM, CEO AB-PMJAY, all the Principals and HODs among other senior officers of the department.

On the eve of Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Maharaj, as per past practice a religious Nagar Kirtan (procession) is being taken out on 03.01.2023 at 0900 hours onwards which will start from Gurudawara Sahib Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji Chand Nagar Jammu and will pass through the following route:

ROUTE OF THE NAGAR KIRTAN:

Gurudawara Sahib Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji Chand Nagar Jammu → Swami Vivekananda Chowk → Gumat Crossing → JP Chowk → Dogra Chowk → Mandir Masjid Tube Bikram Chowk → Asia Chowk → Green Belt Chowk (Lighting) → Gandhi Nagar Hospital Road → Gole Market → Bank of Baroda Chowk → Sachdeva Boutique → Valmiki Chowk Shiva Ji Chowk, → Khalsa Chowk and will culminate at Gurudawara Sri Singh Sabha Nanak Nagar Jammu.

The general public especially the motorists/ PSV operators are requested to follow the following traffic diversions/restrictions for smooth plying of vehicular traffic, so that no inconvenience is caused to general public as well as to devotees taking part in the said Kirtan :-

DIVERSIONS/RESTRICTIONS DURING NAGAR KIRTAN :-

- The vehicles coming from Samba, Kathua and Inter-state vehicles shall be diverted from Kunjwani via Narwal by pass towards Nagrota and onwards.
- The vehicles coming from Poonch, Rajouri, Akhnoor shall be diverted through 4th Tawi Bridge / Bakshi Nagar Pulli.
- The vehicles coming from Indira Chowk bound for JP Chowk/Vivekananda Chowk shall be diverted towards Fly- Over or B.C Road /4th Tawi Bridge (Baghwati Nagar) or as per situation till the procession crosses Dogra Chowk.
- The vehicles coming from Residency Road bound for Dogra Chowk will be diverted towards 4th Bridge Belicharana & onward journey towards Satwari etc.
- Similarly vehicles coming from Katra-Udhampur shall be diverted from TCP Nagrota via Sidhra bye Pass towards Kunjwani and onwards.
- All type of heavy vehicles bound for Katra, Udhampur, Doda, Srinagar will be diverted from Kunjwani till culmination of Nagar Kirtan.

FOR JAMMU CITY BOUND TRAFFIC:

- The Vehicles which are bound for Jammu City/Akhnoor can take the following two routes:
 -) Narwal , Qasim Nagar , PHQ Chowk, Bikram Chowk and Fly over .
 - Qasim Nagar, Gujjar Nagar, Circular Road
- The Vehicles originating in between Kunjwani, Satwari and from R.S. Pura side
 - The Heavy vehicles will opt Beli Charana Road and
 - LMVs will come upto Asia Crossing and will adopt 4th Tawi Bridge for further journey.
- The flyover will remain operational for the whole day with the condition that when the tail of the Procession reaches at Bikram Chowk, the general public can follow two routes:
 - The Vehicles bound for NHW will follow Bikram Chowk, Qasim Nagar to Kunjwani
 - The Vehicles bound for Kunjwani , will take Vigilance Rotary, Flyover to Satwari for onward journey
 - No vehicles will be allowed to use interior lanes of Gandhi Nagar and Shastri Nagar/Nanak Nager when head of the procession reach Bikram Chowk.
- All types of vehicular movement on the route of the procession shall be restricted/diverted depending upon the movement/location of Nagar Kirtan (procession).
- When the Procession will reach Gandhi Nagar the Vehicles coming from Shastri Nagar bound for Dogra Chowk shall be diverted via Last Morh Gandhi Nagar to touch main road (Satwari-Bikram Chowk Road) during the movement of Nagar Kirtan (procession).

➤ There will be no entry of trucks in City Jammu from 08.00 AM to 08.00 PM

Keeping in view the movement and location of procession, the public in general is requested to cooperate with the traffic Police and follow the diversions to avoid the movement on the routes mentioned above and plan their travel accordingly to reach their destinations.
