## Three drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

ANANTNAG: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Friday arrested three drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

As per the details, a party from Police Station Anantnag arrested three drug peddlers identified as Zafar Abbas Sheikh son of Mohammad Saleem resident of Sheikh Mohalla Janglatmandi, Yasir Nazir Kadoon son of Nazir Ah Kadoon resident of Qazi Mohalla, at present Dantari; Zubair Ahmad Turray son of Ghulam Nabi Turray resident of Cheeni Chowk at Achabal Adda Anantnag along with 1.2 Kg Charas & 6 gm Heroin. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered and investigation initiated.

## Crackdown continues against drug traffickers; notices issued to 4 more under NDPS Act 1985

SHOPIAN: In continuation to the war against drug trafficking, the District Administration Shopian on Friday issued notices to four more persons involved in illicit drug trafficking. These drug traffickers, as per notices issued, have been involved in the illicit trade of drugs with the motive of taking illegal proceeds. They have made investment in acquiring movable and immovable properties from the illegal proceeds from the drug trade.

Taking cognizance of their illegal activities, Additional District Magistrate Shopian has issued notices for declaring sources of their movable and immovable properties under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotic Substances Act, 1985. The accused have been asked to attend the ADM office within 30 days. Out of these 4 persons, 2 belong to Zainapora tehsil and 1 each from Chitragram and Barbugh. They have

been further asked to produce documents indicating the source of income, earnings or assets by means of which they have acquired properties and show why acquired properties may not be declared illegal and seized as per the provisions of the NDPS Act. Earlier a few days back, similar notices were issued to 5 persons, with 4 belonging to Shopian and one from Hermain.

## Two houses gutted in Dhaggar

BANI: Two houses and a Cattle Shed were gutted in village Dhaggar, Tehsil Bani reportedly due to short-circuit. Though there was no loss or injury to human life, yet a buffalo and nine goats perished, belonging to two families of Krishan Chand, son of Praga and Muluk Raj, son of Amir Chand. The fire spread out in absence of any fire fighting facility in nearby vicinity as there is no fire station in Tehsil Bani and even in Tehsil Billawar or Basohli.

On receipt of information, SDM Satish Sharma rushed to the spot and assured full assistance to victims. He also announced Rs 10,000 each to both families along with tents and ration. Locals said that eight to nine incidents of fire have been reported in Tehsil Bani and in absence of Fire Station in nearby areas, people remained helpless to save their lives and property. They appealed to LG Manoj Sinha to provide a Fire Station in Tehsil Bani. They also demanded that suitable compensation should be paid to victims so that they could reconstruct their houses and purchase buffalo and goats for their livelihood.

JAMMU: On the occasion of Poornima, Sadguru Madhu Param Hansji Maharaj of Sahib Bandgi said that it is clear from

the study of holy scriptures and the sayings of great sages that our forefathers used to go on spiritual journeys.

"Common people may wonder whether this can happen or not. Some may ask is it a difficult job. The fact is that it is certainly not difficult to do this. With full concentration a man can see many happenings within himself," Madhu Param Hansji said adding that in present times all types of Nirguna Puja are related to five Asanas.

"Vihangam' also needs to be understood. We are following it. We are talking about something that is far beyond these 5 types of postures. We do not deny the existence of such things but they will perish with the destruction of the body. In such a situation, we will not be able to take any benefit from them," he said adding that in Chachari Mudra the devotee has to fix his concentration.

"Whenever a devotee tries to fix his concentration, the breath creates an obstacle. You should try to understand these Mudras but by no means we want to give any message about

these. Mudras can provide us with some information about what is contained within us. Some people call the musical notes emanating from within as God himself," Madhu Param Hansji adding that in such cases the Guru only guides the disciples. It doesn't provide any practical help.

"Saheb Kabir has called Guru as the Supreme Person. He says that there can be no knowledge of the Supreme Person except through a Sadguru, whose abode is far away from all the worlds of Nirjanan. No one can reach there on the strength of his own strength. That's because there are so many scary fads. Nirjanan is very powerful. So only the grace of a Sadguru can help a devotee to reach the Amarloka of the Supreme Person," Madhu Param Hansji said.

Notice for Prohibiting Production, Stocking, Distribution, Sale & Use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items  
Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change has issued notification No. G.S.R 571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 vide which manufacturer, import, stocking, Distribution, Sale and use of identified single use Plastic (SUP) items shall be prohibited with effect from the July 01, 2022.  
As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (amended), "The manufacture import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from 1st July, 2022  
A) Ear Buds with plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration:  
b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straws, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 microns stirrers:  
As per Rules 4(1)-(C) of PWM Rules, 2016 (amended) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic, shall not be less than one hundred and twenty (120) micron in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.  
This notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockists, Retailers, Shopkeepers, e-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/Market place/Shopping Centres/Cinema Houses/Tourist locations/Schools/Colleges/Office Complexes/Hospitals & other institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items.  
Any non-compliance in this regard will attract penal action as per Jammu and Kashmir Non-Biodegradable Material (Management, Handling and Disposal) Act, 2007 and as per its subsequent amendment by Government of India vide Notification No. S.O.1229 (E) dated 31-03-2020 in above which may include fine up to the tune of Rs. 50000/- and punishment for a term which may be extended for a month or both.

#### Standard Operating Procedure for Scrap Dealers

With the notification of Solid Waste management Rules, 2016 by the Government of India and subsequent notification of Jammu & Kashmir Government Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws 2019, it is incumbent upon all that "no waste generator shall throw, burn or bury the solid waste generated by him, on the public places, open public spaces, outside his premises or in drain or water bodies.

According to SWM Rules -2016 ULBs should involve communities in waste management. In this respect SWM Rules-2016 calls for registration of waste pickers and waste dealers and providing the training on the Solid Waste Management to waste pickers and waste collectors. Scrap dealers/Waste aggregators/rag pickers are an essential part of waste management chain and play a vital role to improve the circular economy in waste management sector.

Hence, it has been observed that some of the scrap dealer are not following the rules as notified in SWM rules 2016. As such, following instruction/standard operation procedure is here by outlined to be strictly complied with all the scrap dealers failing which action under rules will be initiated against them.

Every Scrap Dealers must ensure:

- Proper segregation and safe storage of the collected waste.
- Proper are should be earmarked for category wise scrap storage.
- Burning of Solid waste/Plastic Waste strictly prohibited and is punishable offence as per Solid Waste management Rules 2016
- Installation of Boundary/View cutter up to 10 feet height of the premises so that view of the premises could be avoided.
- Boundary wall should be fabricated of GI sheet with 5mm thickness and painted with green color.
- For proper housekeeping and hygiene of earmarked area and beautification of the city should not be affected by the storage center.
- Proper mechanism of fire and safety equipment's must be available at segregation and storage unit proportionate to the waste accommodated in the premises.
- Every scrap dealer to ensure sale of the segregated material to authorized recycler only.
- Every scrap dealer to register himself/his firm with the Municipal Council Rajouri
- Payment of monthly user charge to Municipal Bodies on time:

- Proper Disposal of collected Multi Layered Plastic/Packing Material
- Maintaining of logbook for collected and sale material
- Maintaining the record of rag pickers engaged by them.
- Welfare measures for rag pickers viz. linkage of rag-pickers with social services and insurance scheme viz:
  1. Ayushman Bharat Yojana
  2. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana
  3. Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana
  4. Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Bima Yojana
  5. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana
  6. Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana

## Cattle smuggling bid foiled, 5 bovines rescued

SAMBHA: Police on Friday foiled a cattle smuggling attempt and rescued five cattle from clutches of smugglers. As per the information, a load carrier (JK08D1635) was signaled to stop at Samba Naka by a team from Police Post Kandi but driver accelerated the speed of vehicle and tried to escape. Alert police personnel chased the vehicle, after which driver of vehicle fled leaving vehicle behind at a short distance. During search, five bovines were found laden in vehicle, which were rescued. The vehicle was seized and a case has been registered in this regard.

## Four die in accidents

JAMMU: Four people died in accidents in different areas on Friday. According to information, Ashok Kumar, son of Jai Narayan, resident of Bihar presently living in Karan Bagh area, fell from a height on January 1 while working and got injured. He was admitted in the hospital, but he failed to recover and died during treatment. Apart from this, a person fell from a bus in Kanachak area and died. He was identified as Rajendra Kumar, son of Girdhari Lal, resident of Garota. In another instance, a soldier, identified as Sohail Singh, son of Ramesh Singh, resident of Meen Chadakan, was found dead in his house in Bari Brahma area. Another person died in an accident in Vijaypur area. He was identified as Punjab Singh, son of Hari Charan Singh, resident of Findad, R S Pura.

## Four narco-smugglers nabbed

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed four narco smugglers and recovered heroin and other intoxicants from their possession. According to information, acting on information, Sidhra police arrested two smugglers and during search, recovered 6 gm heroin from their possession. The duo was arrested and a case has been registered against them. Police is now engaged in finding out rest of their links.

Meanwhile, Akhnoor police also arrested a youth with 346 capsules. The accused was identified as Raman Kumar, resident of Gurha Brahma. In another instance, Katra police received information that a smuggler was carrying drugs, after which a Naka was laid and smuggler was intercepted. During frisking, 8 gm heroin was recovered from accused, later identified as Ravindra Kumar, resident of Katra. He was arrested and a case was registered against him.
